Genealogical Society Gives Library Records Of Dallas' Early Days

Giving the Dallas library an interesting addition, copies of the Federal census of Dallas County for 1850, 1860 and 1870, were presented to Edward A. Belsterling as chairman of the library board at a meeting of the Dallas Genealogical Society Thursday night at the Y. W. C. A.

The census records were taken from the originals in Washington by E. B. Comstock, principal of North Dallas High School and first president of the genealogical society. They have been bound in red leather for the library. J. Howard Payne is president of the society.
