If a telephone number is not shown after a member's name in the index, you may assume that this member does not wish to be telephoned and would prefer a written inquiry.


We have tried to eliminate all errors but realize that some, no doubt, will be found. If such errors are called to our attention, we shall publish an errata sheet as soon as possible.
