The sooner they are sent in, the sooner they can be sent to the publisher. Please fill these out immediately and return them if you would like them to be included. You may submit as many as you wish, but they must be on these forms, not any other, because we need them to be uniform in size and information contained. Type, if at all possible, because many types of ink will not print clearly. Get yours in early for the 1st volume. Proof-read each sheet carefully before sending it in.

PEDIGREE CHARTS: Start with any generation you wish. Fill in as completely as possible.

FAMILY GROUP SHEETS: Fill in as completely as possible, leaving anything blank that you are not certain of - someone reading these may have the information you need to fill in the missing data.

NAME AND ADDRESS: Don't forget to put your name and address on each page in the space provided. PLEASE DO NOT use the gummed address labels since they tend to dry out and fall off and we would not have any way of identifying the person who sent in the information. BE A FIRST AND SEND YOUR INFORMATION IN TODAY.

BY-LAWS: The revised by-laws which were in your May 1977 Newsletter were passed unanimously at the June meeting.
