PROJECTS REPORT

Microfilming - Due to the hard work of several of our members, 1,620 Probate packets had been filmed prior to Thanksgiving. The project was 'shut down' for the holidays but is now back in 'full swing' for the filming of the remaining packets to number 3,100. The index is also being typed and should be completed by the time the microfilming is finished.

Publications - Typing is now completed for Vol. I of the Lineage Charts and the index is almost ready to be typed. It is estimated that over 3,000 ancestors names will be in this first volume. The Marriage Records for Dallas County, Books A-D have been typed, proofed and the index is now being prepared. Both of these publications will be ready for the printers soon.
