The Nelson County Historical Society, Bardstown, Kentucky, has sent us a flyer prepared for person to person distribution at Travel Shows during 1980. They felt the information it contained might interest our readers and it pertains briefly to the following:

In 1887, 22 years after the Civil War, in Bardstown, Kentucky, the Sixth Annual Reunion of the Orphan Brigade was held with union soldiers as special guests.....The Nelson County Historical Society is planning to recreate the whole day down to the fancy ball in the evening.

The details of the event have been preserved through a news story written at the time which contains the names of notables and visitors and the names of 65 ladies with descriptions of their gowns. 202 names are listed in the entire account.

The celebration will be held Saturday, September 6, 1980 and they would like to have descendants of those mentioned in the story or any other interested persons to come and join in the festivities.
