DALLAS GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY ANNUAL SPRING WORKSHOP AND BOOK AWARDS SATURDAY, APRIL 27, 1985

A separate notice was mailed to you last month concerning the workshop. Don't forget to send your \$10.00 to pre-register by April 20. Lloyd Bockstruck will speak on research in Virginia and North Carolina.

Book awards are given each year at the workshop. If you would like to enter a book or manuscript you have done please follow these rules: (1) deadline for entries is April 10, 1985; (2) you must be a current member of the Dallas Genealogical Society to enter. Three judges will decide what offerings will qualify for the awards, or if no offering deserves a prize in any of the categories. Each book or manuscript will become the property of the Dallas Public Library, author retaining publication rights. Entries should be sent to Lloyd DeWitt Bockstruck, Genealogy Dept., Dallas Public Library, 1515 Young St., Dallas, Texas 75201 with a letter stating which category they wish to enter. The categories are:

- (1) A book with a minimum of 50 pages about family history or genealogy.
- (2) A book with a minimum of 50 pages about local historical or genealogical interest.
- (3) A manuscript with a minimum of five pages, single spaced, about family history or genealogy.
- (4) A manuscript with a minimum of five pages, single spaced, about local historical or genealogical interest.
