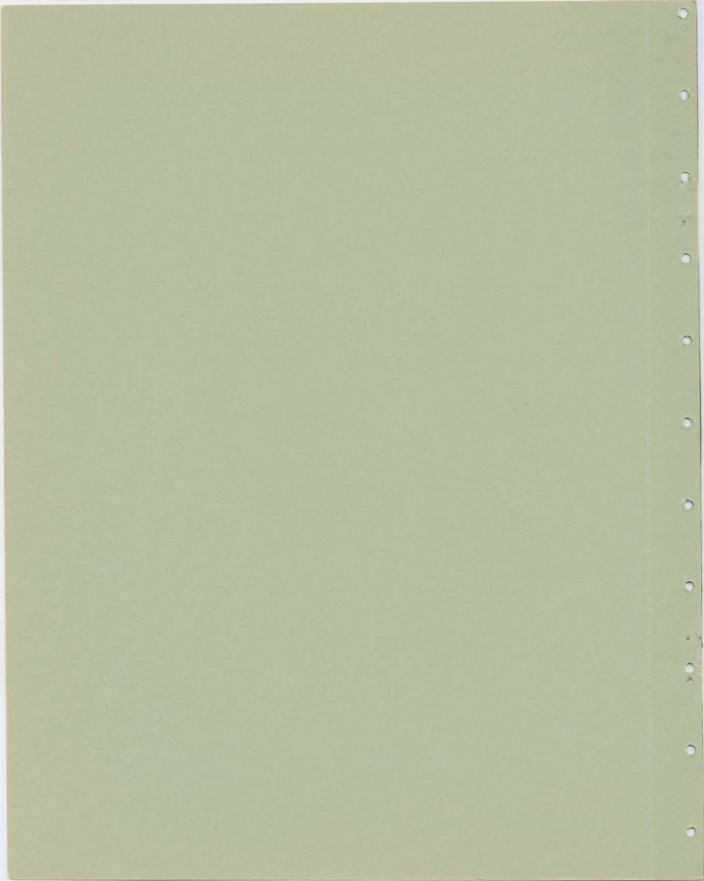

Killed by Indians in May 1836 while detailed from Captain John J. Tumlinson's Company of Rangers to help protect the families of the Hornsby's settlement on return from the "run away scrape."

To: WILLIAM ATKINSON

Pioneer Ranger buried near Daniel Hornsby when both were killed by Indians 7 June 1845. Erected by the State of Texas 1936.

15 MARCH 1822 - 21 MARCH 1862

Josephus Hornsby, son of Reuben, settled here 1832, Bastrop Ranger 1837, in Flores Fight 1839, in Battle of Plum Creek 1840, Brushy Fight 1840, Vasquez and Woll Campaign 1842, led fight against Indians from whom he rescued William Bell and Alexander Coleman in Austin, 1842.

His wife, Eliza Ann Lane, 14 Feb 1830 - 6 Sept 1892.

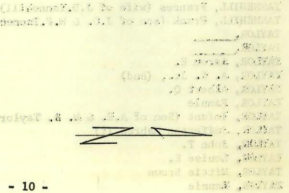
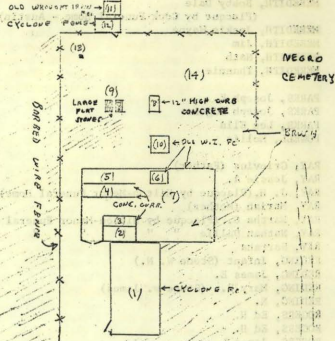
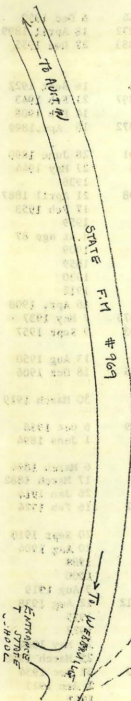

THUMBNAİL SKETCHES  
A PANORAMA OF DALLAS SOCIAL LIFE IV

One of the most enjoyable occasions early in the history of Dallas was the annual reunion of "Old Settlers." This was a family picnic affair with great baskets of fried chicken, cakes, pies, and a wealth of such goodies as is seldom, if ever, seen to-day. The reunion was held in the former Oak Lawn Park - located on the hillside overlooking Turtle Creek at Hall Street, now called Lee Park.

There was a great "swapping of receipts," much "women-talk," and the youngsters engaged in games with their elders. If the day was warm, the creek water, which had not yet been "dammed-up," afforded a delightfully refreshing spot for wading. Usually the time of the gathering was in late Spring or early June, the date being agreed-upon each year in advance. The occasion was eagerly looked forward to by "settlers" who came from far and near. Many of them living too far apart for visiting, used this occasion to "get current" on births, deaths, marriages, and gossip. When there were no scandals to "roll under the tongue," speeches were requested from good orators. General "sing-songs" brought everyone into active program participation - central points for other activities were the pavilion and bandstand. What great variety of excitement! It was truly a memorable day!

As the town grew, and the oldsters "passed to their reward," the prime incentives for gathering gradually lessened to abandonment. The White Rock Camp Meetings were brought to a close in much the same manner. Rather than having a one day meeting, the White Rock Camp Meetings lasted a full week. The programs were described by one participant in this way, "There was church every day and night."

The east bank of White Rock Lake was used as the site of the camp meetings and from this the name "White Rock Camp Meetings" was derived. Tents containing "double-decker" bunks were grouped around a large pavilion. These meetings were primarily known as Methodist because the great majority of early settlers were of that denomination. Farmers from the northern, southern, and eastern sections of the country attended these protracted meetings. To free themselves from domestic obligations, the families brought their cooks and pre-cooked provisions. The most famous and best liked items to be found in the picnic basket were chess pies and fried cakes. Along with the pleasure of the open camp came some of nature's little discomforts. Chiggers, flies, and wood ticks were either cheerfully endured or an effective instrument in driving Christian endurance to a breaking point. Fly paper, citronella, and mosquito netting were put to work upon the arrival of the people. The mosquito netting had two very important uses - to cover food during the day, and to cover people during the night.

The women-folk began preparation for this big event soon after they returned home from the "Old Settlers" meeting they had just attended. The most important part of the preparation was to obtain as many beautiful clothes and lovely parasols as possible. Picture the young swains flirtin', courtin', and makin' eyes! Such "goings' on" had to be accomplished as slyly as possible because the main purpose of the meetings was preachin' and was there preachin'! The preachers' sermons were eloquent and fiery. Praying began at sunrise and continued all through the day and extended into the night. Of course there were sing-songs, solos, choruses, and group gatherings for special instruction throughout the preachin' and prayin'. These meetings were similar to the great Chautauqua, New York programs of yesterday and today, yet they didn't border on secularity. On the contrary, the week's

experience was definitely uplifting and deeply cherished by all who attended. This is the way it was in the 1880-90's and well into the Twentieth Century.

In the old South of this period many of the women were educated in their homes. Despite this fact the arts such as china painting, music, the use of the needle in knitting, tatting, crocheting, or sewing, and other domestic arts were capably and expertly produced. A large portion of the men, their sons, and grandsons were often denied specialized training. This fact was attributed to the "aftermath" of the 1860's. The newness of the country, and the distance between families and adequate instruction facilities.

Godey's Ladies Fashion book and the White House Cook Book were almost universally recognized as the leading reference books on just about every phase of female life. These books were reflections on the court of St. James with modifications to fit the "American Spirit." These books dealt with correct appointments, accessories for serving, meals and parties of every kind and description for every age, everyday home service - formal and informal, dress designing and making, proper selection and fashionable uses of jewelry, proper selection of gloves, the correct gloves and handbags to use for each occasion, and the use of fancy fans and parasols.

What would one wear to an afternoon or evening reception? The hostess, or hostesses, and those receiving with her wore décolleté gowns. The formal wear of a lady was never called a dress, it was always called a gown. The reception gown is not to be confused with the sleeping gown. The sleeping gown of that time had a high neck and long sleeves, while the reception gown was sleeveless, frequently off-the-shoulder, and had a low neck and back. The fashion of the day was to wear jewelry that matched the gown. Rubies were worn with red, emeralds or jade with green, amethyst with lavenders or purples even though carnelians or other stones were a better combination, diamonds or pearls with white, pearls or jet with black, aquamarine with turquoise, lapis lazuli with blue, topaz or certain strains of agate or onyx with yellow. Opals were shunned unless it was your misfortune to have an opal as your birthstone. It was considered a risk for anyone else to wear an opal. The semi-mourning color, grey, in the various tints, tones, and shades permitted a wide choice of gems that were complimentary to the wearer as well as the material and color of the gown.

Long silver, gold or platinum chains of delicately patterned links, sometimes set with stones to match the necklace and earrings, carried dainty "lace fans" or "smelling salts" for resuscitation should one feel faint or swoon. Perhaps a lovely locket was worn on this type of chain although lockets were not usually worn on such long chains. The large lace, hand-painted, and feather fans were restricted in reception because of the chains. A fan was considered a necessity before the invention of electricity. The fan was carried in a gloved hand. The gloves were made of soft, imported, French leather and extended above the elbow. If a term may be coined, there were fine lines of distinction in "costume accessory etiquette" as well as in other "social proprieties" and decorum. From infancy the manor born were exposed to proper etiquette. One grand dame of yesterday has said this of what is proper, "These things one absorbed with one's Mothers' milk." One knew these things or didn't - which spelled tragedy all too often. Because of the consequences suffered if one did not know, the references made to such books as Godey's were frequent. If one was incorrect in dress or manners, the penalty was being ridiculed in the subtle phrases of gossip columns, scandal sheets, or society magazines such as "Beau Monde."

"Beau Monde" was edited by Mrs. Fitzgerald. Mrs. Fitzgerald was to be respected,



feared, and courted with impunity if one was wise and socially aspiring. "Beau Monde" was a type of reporter-sheet magazine in which socially important events were "written-up" in flowery, glowing terms. Of course, this happened when Mrs. Fitzgerald was a participant or if she considered the occasion to be of sufficient weight to deserve short, medium, or lengthy and detailed accounts. Yet, one preferred brief reference to omission, even though one's party numbered as few as four for tea or luncheon. Each issue was first hopefully, eagerly, and rapidly scanned, then it was systematically read from cover to cover. It was unquestionably, automatically dominated by its author-editor. Such power lies in the printed word. Odd, but how true.

Victorian customs and costumes laid quite a lot of emphasis on daintiness and femininity in women. Perfume, jewels, lovely clothes made of rich brocades and velvets and delicate chiffons and organdies were in vogue. Small hats, known as bonnets, were in style. The bonnet was different in contour from a child's bonnet or a sun bonnet. This particular bonnet was largely reminiscent of a man's skull-cap in its general shape. It was placed on top of ones coiffure, sat at a jaunty angle, and was most flattering. Some bonnets had streamers of ribbon trailing down to the shoulders. These bonnets were particularly flattering to young ladies. Added to the flattery of the bonnet was the fancy parasol. The parasol was made of rows of soft chiffon, lace, or silk and was almost miniature in size when compared to a regular umbrella. The parasols had two uses. They could be used as a shield against the sun, or they could be placed in a position that was "most fetching" for coquetry.

No matter how old a person was, there was always an older member of society who could look down on the younger person and give a reprimand for lack of modesty. The over-emphasis of modesty had its falacies. A good example of this would be the obvious insistence that skirts should cover the ankles, yet the skirts were held out by many ruffled petticoats and metal hoops. This caused the ankles to show when walking and dancing. Of course the bloomers were worn under all of the many petticoats. It was considered extremely indelicate for them to be mentioned by anyone. Despite this fact, in the late Victorian Era they appeared brazenly in the open as a part of the costume that is known as the gym-suit.

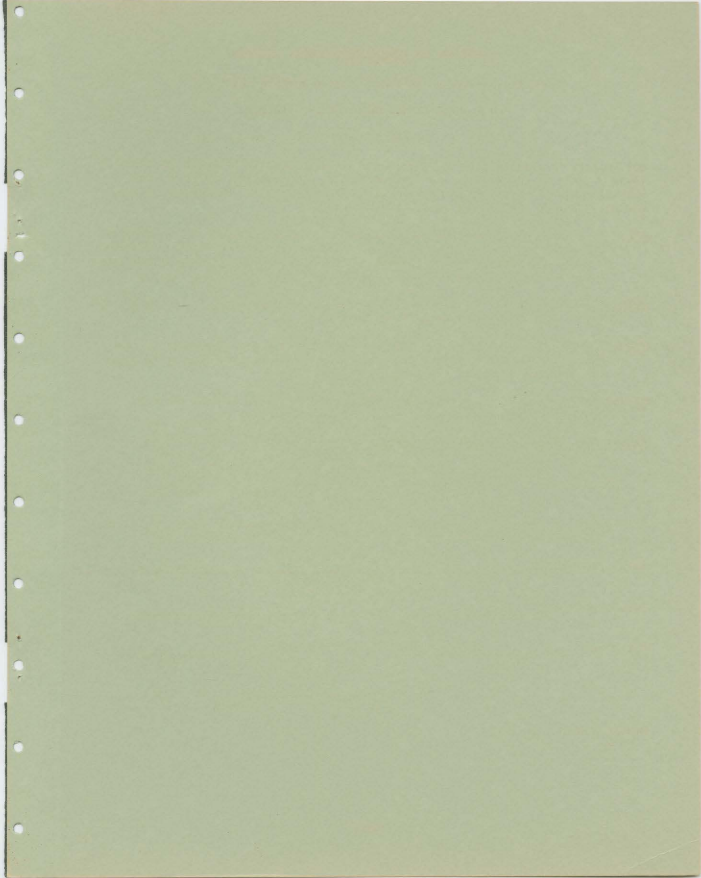
