

Larkin Baker received a land grant that was not patented. It appears he died before he could. His wife Rosannah received a land grant in Peter's colony. The sale of this grant by her heirs can be found in Denton County 1872.

John W. Baker received a grant as an unmarried male in Peter's Colony. He evidently died without issue as his brothers and sisters and their heirs sold their share of his land grant. It appears Larkin Baker was from Lawrence Co., TN, then to Missouri and then to Texas.

BOOK REVIEWS

Nacogdoches Archives - 1835 Entrance Certificates, Compiled by Betty Fagan Burr, Soft Cover, Offset printing, 8½" X 11", 53 pages, Order from, Betty Fagan Burr, 613 Bostwick, Nacogdoches, TX 75961. \$7.95 + \$1.00 for handling, TX tax: 39¢.

This is a plain, unpretentious book with a great amount of information. It is directed toward Texas researchers and those whose ancestors popped up out-west.

All of the information was translated from the original Spanish certificates and is now presented in abstracted form in this book. Listed are the names of each immigrant, their marital status, the names of witnesses, date of the certificate, and (in some cases) the year of arrival into Texas. Some of those listed are of Spanish descent, but many of the surnames are not: there are Mathews, Gates, Howards, and Garners; and the names of witnesses are often similar: Smiths, Grants, Taylors, and Reeds.

The compiler has included an explanation of the State Colonization Law, a map of the Nacogdoches District in 1835, and samples of the six major types of Certificates - everything needed to help the researcher understand the historical significance of these documents.

Clear, large print and eight pages of index make it an easy book to use.

North Carolina Spectator and Western Advertiser (1830-1835) Rutherford County, North Carolina Abstracts, Compilers: Helen Lu and Gwen Neuman. Soft Cover, Offset printing, 5¼" X 8¼", 108 pages. Order from Lu & Neuman, P. O. Box 4276, Station A, Dallas, TX 75208. \$12.00. TX tax: 60¢.

This book is a treasure for researchers with Southern lines, especially in the states of North Carolina, South Carolina, Mississippi, and Georgia. It consists of articles abstracted from the North Carolina Spectator and Western Advertiser, a newspaper published in Rutherfordton, NC. The abstracts are divided into three categories: list of letters from the post office; advertisements, announcements and notices; and vital statistics plus marriages and society news.

The lists of letters are the addresses of letters left at the post office, while rather dry reading for some they are helpful are treasure for others; but everyone will find the book delightful reading. The past marches out of the pages and gives the researcher a sample of his ancestors' daily life; and true to the journalism of the 1830's, many of the death notices are ghoulish in their description, -- they leave nothing to the imagination. The notices of marriages frequently include residences: where the marriage took place, and also where the brides' families lived. Usually the parents of the bride are listed and occasionally, there are humorous views of the editor concerning the ages of the bride and groom.

The 15 pages of index consist not only of surnames, but of headings such as: businesses and churches; towns, states, counties and districts; and fords, creeks and rivers. A fun book to read, and a helpful book for researchers.

First Half Dozen Years, Dallas County, Texas, as Seen Through the Commissioners' Court Minutes. Compilers: Helen Lu and Gwen Neuman. Soft Cover, 5½" X 8½", Offset Printing, 80 pages, Order from Lu & Neuman, P. O. Box 4276, Station A, Dallas, TX 75208. \$10.00, TX tax: 50¢.

Lu and Neuman have taken a dusty, repetitious, hard-to-read record out of the Dallas County Courthouse and made it into a useful genealogical tool.

For the history buff, Dallas history comes forth in a day-by-day serial from October 1847 to November 1852. The exact physical dimensions for the timbers for the jail, the roads as they inch on slowly across the growing town, and the daily business of the court are all recorded.

For the researcher, whose ancestor's land was situated in Dallas, there are the land descriptions with boundaries and near by neighbors listed. And for the Texas researcher who knows only that his ancestor stopped briefly in Northern Texas, this book, because, it was copied in toto, can be employed as an excellent finding device. List of jurors, lists of road workers and names of the officers of the court are there. For some residents of Dallas this was the only instance that their name was recorded in a Texas record.

Although this is not a book that most researchers would read from cover to cover, it is a good reference book with a full name index.

A Style Guide for Genealogists. Manuscript Preparation for Photocopy. Author: Edward D. Seeber. Soft cover and spiral, 8½" X 11", 34 pages. Order from Heirloom Press, P. O. Box 1191, Bloomington, IN 47401. No price given.

This is a neat how-to-do-it book for the family genealogist who is ready to type his manuscript. The author's intention is to show how a camera ready manuscript should appear, so he displays the form that he is presenting by using it as the format for his book.

The book is divided into thirteen sections: from "The Parts and their Forms" to the "Sample Bibliography Entries". Seeber's section on Indexing procedures is excellent, especially his explanations of indexing "foreign" surnames and his suggestions for cross referencing. Also, in his section on punctuation, his paragraph on quotation marks is clear and definite, and his use of underlined words leaves no doubt about the correct method of punctuating quotations.

This book has large print and is easy to read. There are wide margins which leave room for the reader's notations -- a real help for the family genealogist who is planning his book.

This reviewer questions E. D. Seeber's section on placement of footnotes. Placing citations at the foot of the page, a method popular in the 1930's and 1940's, takes up more space, uses more paper, and makes a family history more expensive for the genealogist. The newer approach, which has been accepted for 25 years by university scholars, embeds the citation in the text and eliminates long bibliographic footnotes at the bottom of the page -- thus saving space, presenting a handsomer page, and costing less!

Early Records of Montague County, Texas 1858-1879, Compiled by Navena Hembree Troxel. Soft Cover, 8½" X 11", 95 pages. Order from N. H. Troxel, Rt. 2, Box 79, Gore, OK 74435, \$12.00.

This book of early records is a treat for those researching northern Texas or the area along the Red River. Included in this book are several marriages performed in the Chickasaw Nation (but recorded in Montague Co.). Marriage Book "A", the 1858 Tax List, the 1860 and 1870 Census and Mortality Schedules for Montague Co. An added extra is the 1860 Clay Co. Census. The compiler explains in her introduction that the 1860 Clay Co Census was included because some of the people who are listed in the 1870 Montague Co. Census are found in Clay Co. ten years before. The world of Genealogy needs more compilers of this caliber!

Tucked in between the 1860 Clay Co. Census and the 1870 Montague Co. Census is a page of information concerning the historical places of Montague Co.

Researchers will appreciate the easy-to-read block print and the capital letters used for all surnames listed in the Censuses. Also a tremendous help are the compiler's frequent footnotes concerning exact names and corrected dates that could be considered an error in copying or printing. From these footnotes, it is obvious that N. H. Troxel is familiar with the families of Montague.

An index of almost 1000 surnames completes this informative book on Northern Texas.

Genealogical Periodical Annual Index - Key to Genealogical Literature, 1979.
Compiled by Catherine M. Mayhew, Hardbound, 8½" X 5", 179 pages. Order from Heritage Books, Inc., 3602 Maureen, Suite #301, Bowie, MD 20715. \$15.00

This book has been labeled: "The most comprehensive surname, locality, and subject index to current English language genealogical periodicals." Indeed, it is.

The compiler has perused 147 genealogical quarterlies and has abstracted over tries. The genealogical materials consisted of Bible records, lineages, genealogies, and source records. All entries are indexed under family surname, locality, and subject headings, and each entry is followed by the name of the periodical, the issue and page number.

It is quick and easy to use. Beginners: If you have not used this series before, be sure to read the "Errata".

Stagecoach Library Bulletin. Edited by Jeanne R. Feldin. Published bi-monthly. Annual subscription \$11. Order from 14419 Stagecoach Rd., Magnolia, TX 77355.

This is the July, 1982 issue (Vol. 1, #6) - 38 pages. This quarterly appears to be a serious aid to researchers, and although it is published in Texas, it is not a Texas quarterly. It has National coverage and is the only nationwide genealogical publication that publishes queries free of charge.

This issue contains queries and book reviews, but these articles make it a helpful research tool: a list of firms that repair and restore documents and a list of rare book dealers, also more information about the Sharon Taylor "telephone-book family histories". Another article was on the Hill Junior College History Complex, - of great interest to Confederate researchers and to military history buffs.

For the traveler there was an article on the Avenues Residential Center, an economical hotel for researchers visiting Salt Lake City. There were also reproductions of the 1910 Census form, and articles on "Genealogical Freebies" and "How to Start a Family Genealogical Society."

This was only Vo. I, #6, but for a new quarterly, it looks good, though a bit thin, but promises to be better in 1983.
