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

METRO PAST

Oct. 14, 1885 - The County Commissioners have been in session for two days. The most important business transacted yesterday was an order for an election in the Keller School District to determine whether or not an additional tax of twenty cents on the hundred dollars shall be levied for school purposes. A proposition by D. H. Smith, nurseryman, to rent a portion of the courthouse yard, was rejected.

Oct. 19, 1885 - Saturday evening Mr. Hatfield, who says he is from Lancaster, went to a wagon yard and took therefrom a horse belonging to A. Brownlee. He was afterward arrested leading the horse, but riding one of his own. He was placed in jail, and says this morning that he became so befuddled with whiskey that he didn't know what he was doing. He thought he left the horse in the wagon yard, but when he went after it, he didn't recognize it. The grand jury will investigate the matter, while Mr. Hartfield (sic) muses: "Woe cuss the hour. Woe cuss the day. When I became befuddled and took a gray."

Pp. 2 & 3: John N. BRYAN and Margaret BRYAN convey to Barton Warren STONE of Dallas Co., TX, consideration \$100.00, lots 1, 2, 7 and 9, being the East half of Block No. 53. Signed 20 Dec 1851, recorded 27 Dec 1851. Wit: A. H., Clerk.

Pp. 3 & 4: John N and Margaret BRYAN convey to Agnes DUVAL of Dallas, TX, consideration, \$50.00, Lots 3 and 4 in Block No. 71. Signed 29 Dec 1851, recorded 3 Jan 1852. Wit: A. H., Clerk

Pp. 4 & 5: M. P. MEAD, Administrator of Estate of C. GRIGSBY, of Anderson Co., TX, grants to John GRIGSBY of Anderson Co., TX lands in Dallas County, Texas. Noted that "Probate Court of Anderson County, at the May term, 1847, thereof did make an order appointing the heirs of Crawford GRIGSBY, Dec'd., who were of lawful age and the guardian of minors Robert H. and James GRIGSBY Commissioners of partition to divide and apportion to said heirs the lands belonging to the deceased situated and being in the County of Dallas, consisting of one thousand acres survey, the same being a locative interest in the headright League and Labor survey of John GRIGSBY, Sen." (Note: This entry is not dated, or witnessed, and has been crossed out in the Deed Book).

Pp. 5, 6, 7: John and Margaret C. HEMBY, of Anderson County, TX, Deed to A. HARWOOD and J. W. SMITH, of Dallas County, Texas, for a consideration of \$413.00, "being of Lot No. 5, consisting of 413 acres, a part of the headright of John GRIGSBY Survey No. 23, of 26 labors." Signed 11 Dec 1851. proven by James M. PERRY, N.P., Anderson Co., TX. Recorded 5 Jan 1852, in Dallas County, TX, by A. HARWOOD, Clerk.

Pp. 7 & 8: Alexander HARWOOD conveyed to J. M. PATTERSON, both of Dallas, TX for consideration of \$300.00, interest of an undivided half of following described lot, tract or parcel of land lying situate and being in the County and State of Dallas, Texas, Lot No. 5, allotted to John GRIGSBY, Jr., out of the headright Survey No. 23 of John GRIGSBY, Sr., of 26 labors. Signed 24 Dec 1851 by J. W. LATIMER, Chief Justice, D.C.T. Wit: Alexander HARWOOD, Clk.

Pp. 8 & 9: James GRIGSBY deeded to Calvin COLE (both of Dallas, TX) for consideration of \$60.00, land beginning at the middle of the NE boundary line of James A. SYLVESTER Survey for 640 acres of land, to a stake, and in the SW boundary of Wm. GRIGSBY's 640 acres survey, etc. Wit: J. W. LATIMER, Ch. Justice, D.C.T., Signed 26 Dec 1851, recorded 6 Jan 1852.

Pp. 9 & 10: Abner and Susan KEENE, Grantors, of Dallas, TX give Bond for Title to George W. ROUTH, Grantee, of Dallas, in consideration of \$1,300.00, of which \$650.00 was paid, and when the Grantor receives title, the Grantee will pay the balance for land being in Dallas Co., TX, known as the North half of Section No. 31, Township one north and range three east, as surveyed by W. S. PETERS & Co. Signed and recorded 2 Jan 1852. Wit: A. HARWOOD, Not. P.

P. 11: Z. Ellis COOMBES, of Dallas, TX, gives Power of Attorney to Isaac N. COOMBES of Dallas, TX, Signed 5 Jan 1852, recorded 6 Jan 1852. Wit: A. HARWOOD.

P. 12: Henderson and Charlotte COUCH, of Dallas deed to Isaac CARTER, also of Dallas, in consideration of \$104.00, Cedar Springs tract of land bought by S. G. NEWTON of the heirs of Crawford GRIGSBY. Signed 10 Jan, 1852, recorded 15 Jan 1852. Wit: John B. HIBBERT, and Riley HENSAKER, by mark.

Pp. 13 & 14: Henderson COUCH of Dallas, TX, deeds to Isaac CARTER, in consideration of \$584.00, when title is issued to the settlers of Peters Colony, 146 acres of land more or less, in Dallas County, Texas, on the Northeast bank of the Trinity River. Signed 6 Jan, 1852, recorded 15 Jan 1852. Wit: A. HARWOOD, Clk.

Pp. 15 & 16: Henderson COUCH deeds to Isaac CARTER, in consideration of \$1,292.00, land beginning at NE boundary of Crawford GRIGSBY 640 Acre Survey, thence West to South corner of 61-acre survey in name of Edward W. HUNT, thence East to SE corner of C. G. COLE's Survey #48, thence East to Simcoe POPPLEWELL's South boundary and N. E. corner of John COLE's 640 acre survey, thence South with West boundary of 120 acre tract sold by COUCH to John COLE 800 vs. (Special provision: accept 40 acres sold by COUCH to Iddo A. Pp. 19 & 20: C. G. COLE, of Dallas, TX., Admr., Thomas STOKES, deeds to John H. COLE, of Dallas, TX, 320 acres beginning at stake on South boundary of FORBES and HART's survey No. 90, bounded on East by Isreal JENNINGS' corner, thence South along said JENNINGS Survey; thence West along said JENNINGS Survey. P. 38: John N. BRYAN and Margaret BRYAN, of Co. of Dallas, give Power of Attorney to Adam C. HAUGHT of Dallas County, to manage business, and sell and buy property. Signed and recorded 19 Jan 1852, Wit: A. HARWOOD, Clk (Examined Margaret BRYAN separately).

P. 39: John N. BRYAN and Margaret BRYAN, Grantors, of Dallas County, Deed to John J. EAKINS, Grantee, of Dallas County, in consideration of \$125.00, Lots 2 and 3 in Block 10, in town of Dallas. Signed and recorded 20 Jan 1852. A. HARWOOD, Clk (examined Margaret BRYAN separately).

P. 40: Wm. M. LENARD, of Dallas County, Grantor, gives Tax Deed to Alan BEARD in consideration of \$1.00 cost + .72 = \$1.72. B. F. SMITH assumed \$.72 taxes for year 1848, SMITH refused and failed to pay. Auction was held at Courthouse door 6 May 1851 at which A. BEARD was the highest bidder, \$.72. 320 acres lying on Cedar Bluff Creek, Survey #41. Signed 3 Jan 1852, recorded 21 Jan 1852. Wit: A. HARWOOD, CLK

This 2-Volume set, containing a bibliography of over 30,000 books and microforms valuable to those tracing their ancestry, with full ordering information for each, and order forms, will be available until appx. Dec., 1988. A new catalogue will be released in 1989. This set is a splendid "Working Tool" for every genealogist.

Volume I lists names and addresses of Vendors, has a section of General References, and covers Research Sources by locality, Alabama through New Jersey, including Order Forms.

Volume 2, contains Research Sources: New Mexico through Wyoming; with Regional Listings covering the Mississippi Valley, New England, New Southwest, Old Northwest, and the Pacific Northwest, followed by a listing of publications dealing with foreign research sources throughout the world. The Family Genealogy Section includes family genealogies, family newsletters and biographies. Other works, such as early diaries and publications about Indian captivity, have also been listed here since this makes it possible to include the author's or Indian prisoner's name in the index. Order forms are included, as well as sample forms for census data and pedigree charts, family group sheets, etc. Prices are quoted for these forms, which may be ordered from the above address.

THE ABELL, ABEL, ABLE FAMILIES OF SOUTH CAROLINA - Records and Letters, 1733-1869 by William R. Abell and J. Richard Abell, Des Moines, Iowa, 1985. 8-1/2" x 11", soft cover, spiral binding, 55 pages, offset printing, \$5.00 per copy, postpaid. This may be ordered from William R. The authors are distant cousins, both descended from Abell pioneers from St. Mary's County, Maryland, who migrated to Kentucky in the decade following the Revolutionary War. Neither can claim direct relationship to the South Carolina families. They make no attempt to provide definitive answers to the origins of the South Carolina families of this name, or to provide a thorough genealogical study of those families. They have gathered together and organized available information on the South Carolina families, hoping the information may provide some clues which will be of use in their search for early Abell, Abel, Able progenitors. They have searched the census records, and list heads of households by County and Census Year, and include letters and documents from The Archives and Special Collections of Dacus Library, Winthrop College, Rock Hill, South Carolina. The volume includes an index of names. All the data and information regarding the letters and documents appear to be most carefully recorded, and should be of much assistance to those researching these lines.

This is a roster of all members of the John Cavet Chapter of the United States Daughters of 1812, past and present, and is the Texas Sesquicentennial Project of the John Cavet Chapter. This chapter, the second oldest in Texas, was founded 70 years ago, in 1915. Information on patriots, soldiers, sailors, and their children and children's spouses was obtained from the chapter registrar's files. Many active chapter members supplied information in addition to that contained in the application papers. This new research publication gives the history of the founding on 8 January, 1892, the anniversary of the Battle of New Orleans in 1815, and subsequent history of the Chapter, including a biographical sketch of John Cavet, for whom the chapter was named. Requirements for membership are outlined,

This is a very compact, well planned and presented book, and should be a most helpful tool to those searching for ancestors who fought in the War of 1812, as well as those researching their ancestry for eligibility for membership in the United States Daughters of 1812. The Chapter is to be commended for their efforts in publishing this booklet.

It is unfortunate that this volume has a dated title - for the information it contains is current in almost every respect. Do you wish to look up eligibility requirements or headquarters address for any U. S. Hereditary Society? This is your source book. It also contains extensive information regarding Coats of Arms, Medals, Awards, Rulers of Britain and some Norman Lines, Family Associations, Certified Genealogists, Genealogical Societies, and much more. This is an impressive volume filled with excellent source information for all who are interested in genealogy and heraldry.

The Mountain of Names: A History of the Human Family. by Alex Shoumatoff.
Published by Simon & Schuster, New York, 1985, 318p.

Michael Kalen Smith, of the History & Social Sciences Division, Dallas Public Library, has written the following review of a book which is owned by that division, and which he feels would probably not come to the attention of most DGS members. Mr. Smith writes "I think it should be 'discovered' by genealogists." Mr. Smith has a strong background, academically and professionally, in local history ('anybody's local history' - he claims), biography, and archival materials. We thank him for the following review:

Genealogists are untiring readers, but too few escape the marriage records and cemetery lists and county histories to investigate the more fundamental subjects incorporated in family research. The Mountain of Names is that occasional "mainstream" book for which any genealogist should set aside a few evenings.

Genealogy is fundamentally about kinship, and the reader will find discussed here the historical/social/anthropological reasons behind the development of western individualism, the nuclear vs. the extended family (with lots of shadings between the two extremes), the negative consequences of exclusive male primogeniture (the rule in the British peerage but not in the monarchy itsekf) and why almost all Englishmen have become kin to each other in the 900 years since the Conquest (a textbook example of "pedigree collapse"). Why is knowledge of one's ancestry almost as important to a Moslem as it is to a Mormon? How has the Duchess of Medinaceli managed to accumulate fifty-nine titles? Is it really possible for anyone now living to extend a pedigree back to classical times? And why are American family names disappearing faster than ever before? Shoumatoff's easy, anecdotal style (derived from his years at The New Yorker) as he dovetails one subject into the next will make this a very difficult book to put down.

The title refers to the Granite Mountain outside Salt Lake City where the Genealogical Society of Utah (aka/the Genealogical Department of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints) stores the names of the billion and a half people the church has collected in the forty years since the world-wide microfilming program began. Quoting liberally from other authors and from numerous interviews with LDS higher-ups, Shoumatoff pokes into the historical and doctrinal reasons behind the Mormon obsession with genealogy. Mormons may find his amused but tolerant discussion of their theology a bit annoying, but he is never disrespectful, and in fact gives the self-reliant, highly supportive Mormon social system its full due.

Footnotes are lacking -- and would be intrusive -- but the extensive bibliographical essay at the end of the book should leave most readers with a sizable list of further reading to pursue. A highly recommended book, guaranteed to make anyone readjust their genealogical focus!



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
