PAST PRESIDENT'S REPORT

It is my pleasure to report that the Dallas Genealogical Society is in excellent condition. As of May 26, 1986, we have 23 life members and 522 regular members. The treasury is in excellent shape with a balance in all accounts of about \$12,000. The efforts of the officers and directors of the society and the active participation of our members have made this such a successful year. As reported by the officers at our annual meeting, many have contributed their time and talents over the year.

The Dallas Genealogical Society is the oldest genealogical society in continuous existence in Texas. Meeting first in 1954, our first journal was published in 1955. We are now publishing Vol. 32 of our quarterly. This year we had 7 regular meetings with varied, interesting programs. In honor of our Texas Sesquicentennial this year, a Texas vignette has been presented as part of each meeting. In February, we had a Texas birthday party, which was a festive reception. We have agreed with the State Fair of Texas to co-sponsor a genealogical competition in conjunction with the Sesquicentennial, about which details were published in the June issue of the Dallas Quarterly.

We had two workshops, both very successful: In November an excellent Beginners' Workshop was given by our talented board members; In April Elizabeth Shown Mills gave an outstanding workshop on Mississippi and Alabama, which was a sellout, making it necessary to return checks to 46 people.

The Dallas Genealogical Society each year presents Book Awards to members who have authored outstanding books. 1986 awards were given to Gene Boswell for Descendants of Edward Boswell; an award was also given to Eunice Clark for Clarks from Pennsylvania and Allied Families from Early 1700's to 1984; and to our Newsletter Editor, Joyce Martin Murray for Deed Abstracts of Warren County, Kentucky, 1797-1821.

In September, the Society launched an ambitious project, the purchase of the Revolutionary Service Records, a set of 1096 rolls of microfilm, which will cost a total of \$21,920 to complete. To May 22, 1986, \$11,163. has been donated and 597 rolls ordered. Other patriotic societies and persons have participated generously toward this achievement.

The Dallas Quarterly is a journal of which we can all be proud. It represents our Society in a professional manner. We presently exchange Quarterlies and other publications with 94 other societies. All publications, including books sent for review in our quarterly, are donated to, and represent a substantial contribution to the Dallas Public Library.

As you can see, this has been a productive and interesting year, and it has been my pleasure to serve as your president.

Pp. 296-297: Moses M. Hughes of Navarro County, Texas, Grantor, through his agent, James E. Patton, deeded to George Wilson, Grantee, of Dallas County, Texas, in consideration of \$84.00, 22.38 acres in Dallas County on Cedar Mountain on Cedar Bluff Creek, being part of 2/3 of a league surveyed for James M. Hughes; beginning at the S. E. corner of a lot sold to H. P. Crum, to the S. W. corner of a lot sold Leonard; then to Leonard's S. E. corner. Also near lot owned by A. McCracken and near lot owned by James Russell. Deed signed 24 Sep 1851. WIT; E. C. Newton, William B. Haynes. Proved and recorded 10 Dec 1852; A. Harwood, Clerk.

Pp. 297-298: Wm. E. Russell, Grantor, made Deed of Gift in consideration of love and affection, and \$1.00, from his sister Ann Francis Rice, Grantee, both of Dallas County, of a negro girl named "Sarah," aged about six years, as a slave for life. Signed, acknowledged, and recorded 10 Dec. 1852. A. Harwood, Clerk.

P. 298: David A. Murdock, Grantor, deeded to John King, Grantee, both of Shelby County, Republic of Texas, in consideration of \$500.00, Survey No. 15 of 1280 acres of land by virtue of Land Warrant No. 2697 issued by Elias Mason, Acting Secretary of War on 24 March 1838, for 1920 acres of land on White Rock Fork of the Trinity near the great Military Road from Austin to Red River beginning at the West corner of 1250 acre Survey No. 14. Crosses the Trinity twice. Surveyed by W. A. Farris, Deputy Surveyor for Nacogdoches. Signed 21 Dec 1840. Witnessed by Thomas Wright & M. Moseley, 30 Dec 1840 before G. Rusk, C.J.C.C. Shelby County, N. P. Recorded 13 Dec 1852. A. Harwood, Clerk; Wm. W. Peak, Deputy Clerk.

P. 316: Wm. M. Simpson, Grantor, gave Power of Attorney to Thos. R. Buford, Grantee, both of San Augustine County, Texas, granting plenary powers to transact all matters of business in Grantor's interest. Signed 24 Nov 1852. WIT: A. D. Alexander & J. A. Simpson; recorded 24 Dec 1852.

P. 317: Wm. M. Simpson, Grantor, of San Augustine County, Texas, in consideration of four \$100.00 notes dated May 3, 1852 and note for \$36.15, with provision that 10 per cent interest on notes begins from 3 May 1853, deeded to F. W. Dunaway, Grantee, 281 acres of land on White Rock Creek adjoining Ellis C. Thomas, on Farmers Branch, adjacent also to Jas. Armstrong and Alexander Thomas. Notes in consideration payable by Samuel D. Pryor, A. D. Rice and A. Harwood, 18 mos. after date at 10 per cent interest. Signed and recorded 24 Dec 1852 by T. R. Buford, agent for W. M. Simpson. No witnesses shown.

P. 318: A. G. Walker, Grantor, in consideration of \$230.00, deeded to S. B. McComas, Grantee, both of Dallas County, 213 acres of land purchased from Wm. M. Cochran, adjoining Edw. C. Browder, T. C. Hawpe, and John D. Floyd. Signed 21 Dec 1852, acknowledged and recorded 24 Dec 1852. No witnesses shown.

P. 320: Wesley Morgan, Grantor, in consideration of One Hundred Dollars (\$1.00) (SIC) deeded to Henry Ward, Grantee, both of Dallas County, four lots, land being in the Town of Dallas, N1/2, Block 64. Signed, acknowledged and recorded 25 Dec 1852. No witnesses shown.

P. 321: John Casey, Grantor, of Dallas County, Texas, in consideration of \$264.00, deeded to John D. Alston 264-1/4 acres of land near Rowlets Creek, part of the colonial headright of John Casey at White Rock Point.

Signed 17 Nov. 1851, by John Casey (his wife, Sarah, signing by mark), proven 30 Jan 1852 before Robert R. Tucker and Berry Page, Witnesses, and recorded 27 Dec 1852.

P. 322: John N. Bryan, Grantor, in consideration of \$50.00, deeded to Henry Ward, Grantee, both of Dallas County, Lots 5 and 6 in Block 71, in the Town of Dallas. Signed, acknowledged and recorded 28 Dec 1852. No witnesses shown.

P. 323: John N. Bryan and Alexander Cockrell, Grantors, in consideration of \$50.00, deeded to Adolpha Gouhenant, Grantee, (all parties being of Dallas, Texas) Lot No. 5, Block 14, in the Town of Dallas. John N. Bryan signed; Alexander Cockrell signing by mark. Acknowledged and recorded before A. Harwood, Clerk, on 28 Dec 1852.

P. 324: Calvin G. Cole, Grantor, in consideration of \$1,000.00, gave Deed and Bill of Sale to Jas. and Enoch Horton, Grantees, (all being of Dallas County), for negro man slave named "Alson," mulatto complexion, age about 30 years. Signed and acknowledged 27 Dec 1852 (no witnesses shown). Recorded 28 Dec 1852.

P. 325: Calvin G. Cole, Grantor, in consideration of \$300.00, deeded to Jas. and Enoch Horton, Grantees, (all of Dallas County) Lot No. 3 in Block 6, in Town of Dallas. Signed 27 Dec 1852. Acknowledged and recorded 28 Dec 1852. No witnesses named.

Pp. 325-326: Amon McCommas, Grantor, as Chairman, Board of Commissioners, Dallas County in consideration of \$56.50, deeded to Obadiah W. Knight, Grantee, of Dallas County, Lots Nos. 6 and 7 in Block 16, in the Town of Dallas, formerly owned by John N. Bryan and Margaret, his wife. Signed 6 Sep 1851. WIT: T. C. Hawpe. Recorded 28 Dec 1852.

P. 326: Amon McCommas, Grantor, Chairman, Board of Commissioners, Dallas County, in consideration of \$60.25, deeded to John M. Crockett, Grantee, of Dallas County, Lot 1, Block 22 and Lot 7, Block 36, in the Town of Dallas. Signed 7 Sep 1852. WIT: F. C. Eakins. Rec: 28 Dec 1852.

P. 328: James B. McPherson on 18 Nov 1852 executed his promissory note to Calvin G. Cole, due two months after date, in the amount of \$149.45, for one Billiard Table. Ack/recorded 29 Dec 1852. No witnesses shown.

Pp. 328-329: James H. Parson, Grantor, of Collin County, Texas, gave Title Bond to Daniel Hering, Grantee, to make a Deed to Hering upon receipt of \$640.00 consideration, covering land on Rowlet Creek, a tributary of the East Fork of the Trinity River, being part of the headright of James Howard's Headright No. 75 issued by the Board Land Coms. of San Augustine County 1 Feb 1838 and transferred to Wm. S. Book and pattened (sic) by the Governor of Texas to corr (correspond?), and recorded in Clerk's Office in Town of Dallas. Beginning at N. corner, part of Daniel Christ's survey to A. Gledwell's corner to Christ's N. W. boundary. Signed 10 Jul 1851. WIT: Geo. H. Pegues, Anna. Filed 30 Dec 1852.

P. 330: William M. Simpson, of St. Augustine County, Texas, through his attorney Thos. R. Buford, in consideration of three notes, each at 10 per cent interest, two for \$100.00 each, one for \$10.00, payable by Wm. Jenkins, J. E. Jinkens and A. Harwood, due May 1, 1853, plus \$50.00 cash, deeded to Wm. Jenkins 250 acres on White Rock Creek from mouth of Wm. Jenkins Branch adjoining land sold by Wm. Simpson to A. D. Jackson, part of original survey of 1,280 acres No. 19. Signed 31 Dec 1852.

Prence, with the permission of the author) is to refer to the Contents, which lists in the following order: "Introductions," "Getting Started," "Keeping Your Records," "Citing Your Sources," "Local and State Records," "The National Archives," "A Final Word," "Appendix I. Glossary," "Appendix II. Helpful Books to Read," "Appendix III. Important Finding Aids," "Appendix IV. National Archives Field Branches," Appendix V. SAN JACINTO COUNTY, TEXAS MARRIAGE RECORDS, 1871-1910, Compiled by Patricia H. (Heffron) Marburger, and published and copyrighted by her in 1986. 81 pages.

This obviously well researched and well executed book states that "San Jacinto County, Texas, was formed in 1870 from the Counties of Liberty, Polk, Montgomery and Walker."

It is further stated that the marriage records contained were compiled from typed records exactly as they appeared on microfilm. The Grooms are listed alphabetically, and a Bride's Index lists the surname and page number. If the record of an 1870 marriage is sought, Polk County should be checked, as microfilm records of San Jacinto County begin with 1871. The compiler suggests that the researcher order a copy of the original records from the County Clerk, San Jacinto County, Coldspring, TX 77331. The alphabetical listing of Grooms, under columns headed "Groom," "Bride," "Date," "Volume," and "Page" occupies 69 pages, while the alphabetical listing of the Bride's Index takes up 11 pages. Approximately 35,000 surnames are covered.

This attractive book is 8-1/2" x 11", with covers of white card stock, printed in black ink and bound with black tape; it is priced at \$12.50, plus \$1.00 handling charge. It is available for immediate delivery and

HISTORY OF SANILAC COUNTY, 1834-1984, Hazel Arnold Trumbull, Editor, assisted by Philomena Falls and Jane Miller, Associate Editors, and an Editorial Board of 11 members and 25 contributing authors. It was published as part of the 1984 Sesquicentennial Celebration of Sanilac County, Michigan, located on the "thumb" of Michigan, about 50 miles North of Detroit, and just a short drive from Canada.

The Table of Contents reveals the interesting history of Sanilac County from 1834 to 1984 under the following headings: Historical Board; Contributing Authors; Acknowledgments; Table of Contents; Introduction to Indian Chapter; The Original American Indian Bibliography; Sanilac Petroglyphs; Reed Gordon and Indian Artifacts; The Great Fire; The Storm of 1913; The Great Courthouse Conflict; Today's Courts; Sanilac County; Sanilac County Officials; Sanilac County's Number One Industry - Agriculture; Education in Sanilac County; Villages, Cities and Townspeople; Family Biographies; Memorials, Donors, Patrons; Happenings of Recent Vintage; Sanilac County's New Flag; Little Known Facts.

Vignettes of some 322 family histories and many illustrations and family photographs are included which are of special interest to the genealogist. These are arranged alphabetically by family name, and though they are not indexed, they contain much valuable genealogical information. They are followed by two pages of Memorials, which are also informative. The map of Sanilac County serves as end papers for this handsome book, the cover of which is of gold-embossed red leatherette material. The front cover depicts the Sanilac Historical Museum, located in Sanilac, which is described as "a beautiful Victorian mansion built in 1872 by Dr. Joseph Loop for his family residence and Office." Dr. Loop was the first doctor to practice in Bark Shanty (Port Sanilac), in 1852. The mansion was donated to the Sanilac County Historical Society by the grandson of Dr. Loop, Captain Stanley C. Harrison.

This County History is 8-1/2" x 11", with its 311 pages printed on white, slick paper. It is a beautiful and interesting book which is being presented to the Genealogy Section of the Dallas Public Library, and which will provide an excellent tool for any who are researching that area. Price and availability of this County History were not supplied with the book, but could be determined by writing to the Sanilac Historical Society, in Sanilac, Michigan.

AMERICAN SURNAMES, by Elsdon C. Smith, published by Genealogical Publishing Company, Inc., Baltimore, Maryland, 1986. Copyrighted by the author, 1969. Originally published by Chilton Book Company, 1969.

The contents of this attractive 5-1/2" x 8-1/2" soft cover book are explained by the Foreword, which describes 1. "Classification of Surnames"; 2. "Surnames from Father's Name-Patronymics"; 3. Surnames from Occupation or Office": "Surnames from Description or Action-Nicknames"; 5. "Surnames from Places"; "Surnames Not Properly Included Elsewhere," followed by Bibliography and Index.

Perhaps the most interesting are the Tables of: 1. "Commonest Names in the United States in 1790," which lists 50 names with Smith leading the lists; 2. "Surnames in Cities in Order of Frequency," with Sullivan heading the list in Britain, Johnson in Chicago, Smith in New York, Johnson in Minneapolis, and Smith in San Francisco).

In "The Most Common Surnames in the United States," it is Smith in a 26-page list with an estimated 2,238,400 persons. The list contains English, Irish, Scottish, Welch, German, French, Swedish, Norwegian, Danish, Italian, Spanish, Portuguese, Grecian, Polish, Hungarian, Russian and Chinese names.

The 2-1/2 page Bibliography and the 40-page Index are most impressive.

Appropriately, Mr. Eldon C. Smith, B.S., LLB, with Professor Erwin C. Gudde, founded the American Name Society in 1951, which is the foremost authority on American Names. Mr. Smith practices law in Chicago.

The book is priced at \$12.95, plus \$1.25 postage and handling, and may be ordered from The Genealogical Publishing Company, Inc., 1001 North Calvert St., Baltimore, MD 21202. You will want this book for your own library.

UNDERSTANDING COLONIAL HANDWRITING - by Harriet Stryker-Rodda, C.G., F.N.J.H.S., who has 50 Years of experience as a Researcher, Teacher, Lecturer and Author, published by the Genealogical Publishing Company, Inc., 1001 North Calvert Street, Baltimore, MD 21202, 1986.

This 5" x 8" soft cover booklet is definitely one of the most valuable working tools for the genealogist and all who are doing genealogical or historic research. It is compact, concise, and most informative. Illustrative samples of Colonial handwriting, and Mrs. Stryker-Rodda's comprehensive presentation on "Understanding Colonial Handwriting," followed by "Letter Forms Found in American Handwriting, 1640-1790"; "17th Century Script, A Comparison"; "Signatures Found in Local Public Documents, 1750-1820" are splendid and truly make this 27-page booklet an excellent, most useful tool, and a must for all researchers. FINDING OUR FATHERS - A GUIDEBOOK TO JEWISH GENEALOGY, by Dan Rottenberg, published by The Genealogical Publishing Company, Inc., Baltimore, MD, 1986, Copyright 1977 by Dan Rottenberg, originally published by Random House, Inc., 1977.

Attractively designed, this is primarily a "how to" book appropriately appearing at the Passover anniversary, in which Dan Rottenberg proves to American Jews that they can mount a successful search for their ancestors by probing the memories of living relatives, by examining marriage licenses, gravestones, ship passenger lists, naturalization records, birth and death records and other public documents, and by looking for clues in family traditions and customs.

But, more than a "how to" book, this is a guide to tracing Jewish ancestors abroad, a list of Jewish family history books -- an aid to researching Jewish genealogy in Mormon records in Israel. It presents a "Guide to Jewish Names and Their Origins," as well as a Guide List of Jewish Family History Books."

All of the following is as presented on Contents pages xiii and xiv: Preface, Acknowledgments, I. "Our Link with the Past"; II. "Starting Out"; III. "Public Records in the United States"; IV. "A Quick Course in Judaica"; V. "Tradition, History and the Bible"; VI. "Jewish Sources in America"; VII. "Back Across the Ocean"; VIII. "Back in Israel"; "A Source Guide to Jewish Family Genealogies, Introduction, Abbreviations, Alphabetical List of Family Names." It comprises 226 pages, with a Bibliography of 15 pages, plus 2 pages of Jewish Reference Books; 2 pages of General Judaica; with 6-1/2 pages of International Judaica covering 19 foreign countries, 5 foreign countries in the Western Hemisphere, the entire United States; and Asia, which includes Burma, India, Iraq, Africa and Australia, providing a gigantic record of sources. The format also includes illustrations, the back cover of the book carrying "A Sampling of Names in the Index," of six columns of Jewish Surnames listed in alphabetical order, of approximately 288 surnames. Truly a book rich in source material and information on "Finding Our Fathers."

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B I B L E A N D C E M E T E R Y R E C O R D S

AN OLD FAMILY BIBLE OF THE GAUSE-PEURIFOY FAMILY, PUTNAM COUNTY, GEORGIA.

This Bible was purchased by a friend, who bought it at the Southern Baptist's Radio-Television Commission, 6350 West Freeway, Fort Worth, Texas, (Paul M. Stevens, Director) a number of years ago, and presented it to me knowing of my interest in everything pertaining to genealogy and my love for all Bibles -- especially old Bibles. On the inside front cover, a handwritten inscription appears, no longer legible except "was printed in 1789." It was published by Jacob Johnson, and Kimber, Conrad & Company, 1807. On the following page was:

THE NEW TESTAMENT, OUR LORD AND SAVIOUR JESUS CHRIST,
TRANSLATED OUT OF THE ORIGINAL GREEK AND WITH
THE FORMER TRANSLATIONS DILIGENTLY COMPARED AND REVISED
- P H I L A D E L P H I A -
PUBLISHED BY JACOB JOHNSON, AND KIMBER, CONRAD, & CO. - 1807,
KIMBER, CONRAD & CO., PRINTERS.

Interestingly, the pages are not numbered, but each right-hand page is numbered or titled as a Chapter. The first four pages have been torn from the Bible so that the fifth page is the first page intact. Printed on the top margin of the page is - "Rachel's darkness - Chap. XXX - She beareth Joseph." The next page, which is the left-hand page, has printed on the top margin of the page - "Jacob's Policy to Become Rich - Genesis - He departeth from Laban." The next page, which is the right-hand page has printed on the top margin of the page - "Laban overtaketh Him - Chap. XXXII - His Covenant with Jacob." Proceed on to "The Second Book of Moses, Called Exodus," etc., on through the "Book of Malachi," which ends with a left-hand page preceded by a right-hand page which has printed on the top margin - "Israel's Profane Disrespect to God - Chap. II - Priests Reproved for Neglect." The next left-hand page has printed on the top margin - "By Christ's Messenger, & C Malachi - Blessings Promised to the Godly." The next page is a right-hand page on which is printed "The New Testament" - as previously quoted above. This is followed by a blank page on which is written by various hands of birth, marriage, baptism, and death records. The next page, a right-hand page, is titled "The Gospel According to St. Matthew," and on this page more records are handwritten. They are transcribed probably with a quill pen and "home-made" ink, which is now faded and dim. The vital records have been written over the printing which was on the title page of "The New Testament," on the front and back of it, and on "The Gospel According to St. Matthew," as follows:
