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EDITOR'S DESK

In the continuing saga of Beatrice Bayley, Elizabeth Ross, The Genealogy Room of Scranton, Pennsylvania, and the Halberts -- all of whom have been deluging genealogists across the nation with their offers of researched information on their own family names -- apparently the Post Office has taken a hand, and are investigating these and others doing likewise. According to the Antique Week (formerly the Tri State Trader) in recent weeks, Beatrice Bayley has declared bankruptcy, and it is reported that the postal department has refused delivery of mail (with the exception of requests for refund) to some, or all, of the others.

Clytes Cullar, a former board member of DGS, is well known to most of our members. She has helped in copying records at the Courthouse in years past enabling us to publish the early Dallas Deed Books, and has helped in countless other ways to further the business of our society. In the past two or three years, Clytes has headed both the Gen. Levi Casey Chapter, DAR, and the Dallas branch of the Magna Carta Society. She has authored several genealogical books -- of recent vintage, "Carriages Along the Trinity," the story of the Guillot family of early Dallas. Clytes, who had polio as a child, is suffering from a "post polio syndrome," causing her to lose her power of speech, with many other complications, including the inability to eat solid foods. The doctors offer no hope for improvement or cure, but she is a person of great faith and courage. We owe her a debt of deep gratitude for her generous service to us. She has recently moved, and I will be glad to furnish her address to any of our members who will call me (942-0550).

Your new editor, as of the September issue, will be Madalyn Crane. I have thoroughly enjoyed being your editor, and I know she will enjoy it, too. If you find good genealogical "filler" material, or material you feel she might want to publish, please send it to her at the DGS P. O. Box No. And -- please be **sure** to keep her provided with queries for the Query Section of the Quarterly. I don't know how some other genealogical quarterlies can publish page after page after page of queries, as we just don't receive queries from you in such quantities. A good query section will help draw interest to our society and its members.

As I leave office, I would like to say a special "Thank you" to those who have been so helpful to me. Margaret Ann Thetford obtained permission for us to use "METRO PAST" items from the Dallas Morning News which have helped to provide a special Dallas "flavor," to our Dallas Quarterly. Jeanne Tabb has copied for us a number of interesting census excerpts and other material for publication. Margaret Hudson, following the death of Mrs. Morris, has prepared our Book Reviews. Kelvin Meyers, when he found we were running out of early Dallas Marriages, headed to the Courthouse, and copied some more years for us! -- and Pat Hatcher has consistently alphabetized the Dallas County Marriages. My own computer will do the comparatively small job of alphabetizing the index to the Quarterly, but I don't have a program that will handle all those marriages! -- And then, of course, there is our Board, each one of whom has contributed of his or her time and effort to "make it all come together" for us. Robert Johnsey, aside from tending to the mailings, has been of special help to me. Both he and Pat Hatcher have the same kind of computer as mine -- and I've issued many an S.O.S. to one or both of them. I've really had lots of willing helpers, not the least being our president, Norma Cansler! It became necessary to postpone publication of the Trees Cemetery records, as they included some interesting fineline drawings of the cemetery. They will given to Adrienne Jamieson to include in the DGS cemetery project. I thank Hazel Peterson for providing us with the 1878-1881 Ledger of the Gabriel Friend Jack mercantile establishment of Newport, Texas, probably including forebears of some Dallas families of today. Hazel, a charter member of DGS, now lives in Denton.

So now, while you are all heading off for far interesting places to do summer research, I'm going to try to find out once again what it feels like to be able to get to the Library for my own research! I hope you all have wonderful results from your summer searches -- and that I can find out how to go about it once again!

Miller to secure payment for loan of \$177.60 payable in twelve months with 10 per cent interest from date, in connection with land on the waters of Ten Mile, or Pleasant Run, Creek, Sec. 15, Range 1, West of principal meridian and Twp. 3 S. of 1st base line as surveyed by W. S. Peters and his associates, where his residence and farm were situated. Signed and acknowledged 6 Dec 1852, recorded 18 Dec 1852. Noted that parties to this transaction were well known to Clerk A. Harwood.

Pg. 310: Amon McCommas, Chairman, Board of Commissioners, granted Deed to William M. Wallis of Dallas County, Texas, in consideration of \$78.00, by authority vested by Legislature and by Deed from John N. Bryan and Margaret Bryan, to Lots Nos. 1 and 2 in Block 69, and Lots 5 and 6 in Block 345 as drawn in map of Town of Dallas, and as conveyed by John N. Bryant and Margaret, his wife, Signed 7 Sep 1852, proven and recorded 20 Dec 1852. Wit: F. G. Eakins.

Pg. 311: William F. Newton and Polly, his wife, in consideration of \$625 deeded to Carlos Wise, all parties being of Dallas County, Texas, land on Five Mile Creek, beginning at S.E. Corner of W. S. Ricketts Survey No. 29b, and in a line of Survey No. 25b, 320 acres located and surveyed by virtue of headright certificate of Wm. H. Newton, deceased. Issued by Thomas W. Ward, Comm'r. of Peters Colony 26 Mar 1851. Wm. H. Newton never married, and left no surviving wife or child, thus Wm. F. and Polly Newton, the parents of Wm. H. Newton are his sole heirs. Signed, acknowledged and recorded 20 Dec 1852, Polly Newton signed by mark. Noted that these were personal acquaintances of W. W. Peak, Deputy Clerk.

Pg. 313: Adolphe H. Gouenant of Dallas Co, TX, for \$5.00 and other considerations, deeded to Enos S. Look/Lock of Red River County, Texas, land in the Town of Dallas: Lot No. 4, Block F, South of and fronting the Public Square, containing the "Arts Saloon" among other improvements, all subject to sale at auction if Gouenant should default. It was expressly understood that Gouenant was indebted to Francis N. Vassallo for \$244.00, note of even date, with interest at 8 per cent, due in six months. Newton of Ellis County, in consideration of \$40.00, deeded to Jonas Baker, also of Ellis County, 5 acres in Dallas, Texas, being part of a league survey for James Hughes in Cedar Mountain on Cedar Bluff Creek from Allen Lemon's. Signed and proven in Ellis County 27 Sep 1853 before Elbert C. Newton, Notary. Copy of Deed recorded in Dallas County 3 Nov 1853. Wit: W. W. Peak, Deputy Clk.

Bryan and Margaret Bryan, of Dallas Co., Texas, through Thomas Roper, their Agent and attorney-in-fact, in consideration of \$1,200.00, gave Bill of Sale to Crawford Trees of Dallas Co., Texas for the three slaves, PATSY, about 35 years, CLARINDA, a girl about 4 or 5 years, and GEORGE, son, about 6 months. Signed and acknowledged 7 Nov. 1853 by Thomas Roper as Agent for John N. Bryan, before John Lanier, Notary Public, and recorded 9 Nov 1853.

Pp. 57-59: William T. Edmonson of Dallas Co., TX, in consideration of \$2,400.00 bond sold to Jacob Martin of Dallas County, Texas, certain lands for which Edmonson was to obtain a patent or title from the government. These lands were: a tract or parcel of land situate about one mile and a half North of the Cedar Springs, it being Edmonson's then-residence, known and described as being: 40 acres of land lying on the W side of Sec. 16, the same being the headright of Henderson Couch. . . Also, another tract or parcel of land containing 61-1/4 acres more or less. . . beginning at the NE corner of sd. fraction, and the SE corner of Calvin G. Cole's survey . . . a stake in a mound and in the NE boundary of Miles Bennett's survey . . . thence N with the W Boundary of Henderson Couch's survey. . . Also, another tract or parcel of land. . . beginning at a stake in the W line of Miles Bennett's Survey at a point where the East line of Section No. 31 of T. IN. INDEX FOR NEWPORT, TEXAS STORE LEDGER NO. 2, 1878-1881
KEPT BY GABRIEL FRIEND JACK, MERCHANT

The original ledger herein described was inherited by Gabriel Jack's granddaughter, Naneen Wilson Shepard, through whose courtesy the ledger is in the custody of our long-time member, Hazel A. Peterson, compiler of this abstracted information from the ledger. Miss Peterson has furnished a complete, duplicated copy of the entire ledger, along with some miscellaneous papers found inside the ledger and of the same vintage, to the Genealogical Section of the Dallas Public Library, and another full copy and paper have also been presented to the Edwards Public Library in Henrietta, Texas for research purposes, probably after binding of the ledger.

NOTES:

- "(181)" varying name between reference in original ledger index and name used on page for account, shown as "181," for example.
- "a," "b," etc.: added to the original unnumbered index pages.
- "Lady": used by Gabriel Jack apparently as nickname for "wife" conducting business for or on the account of husband.
- Names cited in this index are for business account of purchases and payments, for others acting apparently for persons in whose name the accounts were set up -- for purchases or payments, for towns cited, and for business firms listed. "(son)" -- also listed on accounts.
- Comments also made for special methods of payment -- as for exchange of services for payment of accounts.
- (C) indicates "Cotton account." Cotton accounts shown on pp. 258 and 260 of ledger show that from September, 1879, through January, 1880, Gabriel Jack's store handled 13,580 lbs. of cotton for Rose & Palmer from 24 of Jack's customers. In September, October, and November of 1880, Jack's store handled 4665 lbs. of cotton from 11 customers for Gallemore Bros. His other accounts show that he not only handled a wide variety of merchandise for men, women, and children, but Jack also frequently lent money to various customers, listing the loans and payments for loans along with the purchases accounted for. The original map was published by The Tanner Company and hangs in the DeGolyer Library at Southern Methodist University. The reproduction was made possible by cooperation among Dallas Teachers Credit Union, DeGolyer Library and Riverside Press.

This early map of Texas, shaded with several colors, shows many features of great importance to the pioneer traveler. Land features such as river crossings and creeks, roads and towns, such as Galveston, San Felipe de Austin, S. Antonio de Bexar, are shown. Also listed are Indian villages and empresario grants. Empresario grants such as Zavalla, Wheins, Austin, DeWett, McMullin and McGlone, and Burnet are shown. Notes were also made on the location of salt springs, iron ore, silver mines, large droves of wild cattle and horses, etc.

BIOGRAPHICAL REGISTER, SAINT ANDREW'S SOCIETY OF NEW YORK, Vol. II, 1807-1856, by W. M. MacBean, 325 pages, New York, 1926, Index to biographies only. Number 9 of limited edition of 400. Gift of Mattie L. (Carr) Hughes.

This second volume of the St Andrew's Society completed the record of the first one hundred years of the group. The biographies are in numerical order, most likely as they joined.

The St. Andrew's Society was composed of Scotsman and those of Scottish descent who were engaged in charitable and social activities. The biographies cover the period from 1739 to 1900 and all the men appear to lived in New York.

Bishop Garrett, an Episcopal Bishop, kept a daily journal for 50 years - from the date of his consecration as Bishop of the Missionary District of Northern Texas until shortly before his death on Feb. 18, 1924 at age 92.

This is valuable "primary" source material recorded by the one who

observed or participated in the events at the time.

This book contains genealogical and church and town history items as observed by Bishop Garrett, who arrived in Dallas New Years Eve, 1874. Not only does he lists the name of the person baptized, but also the parents, god parents and many times place of birth. The earliest birth date found so far was that of a woman born in 1802 to parents also named.

Based in Dallas, the Bishop traveled throughout Texas recording not only Baptisms, Confirmations, Marriages and Burials, but also observations of towns, buildings, town's people and persons he stayed with and the means by which he traveled.

This valuable historic and genealogical record of Texas is helpful, not only to those who had ancestors who were Episcopalians, but especially anyone doing research between 1880 and 1890. Bishop Garrett did not limit his observations to Episcopalians only.

A humorous look at genealogy and genealogist. Included are such topics as Browsing in Cemeteries; County Courthouses - Burned Down and otherwise; You Will Have an Affair with Your Postman and many more that all can identify with. Everyone who has done genealogy or knows a genealogist can relate to some topic.

GENEALOGICAL RECORDS IN TEXAS, by Imogene K. Kennedy and J. Leon Kennedy, 248 pages, 1987, 7" X 10", hardcover, \$35.00 plus postage - \$1.25 first book, \$.50 each additional book, Genealogical Publishing Co., 101 N. Clavert St., Baltimore, MD 21202. MD residents add 5% Sales Tax.

The greater part of this book is a guide to Texas counties, arranged alphabetically. The following information is given for each county: pronunciation where necessary, county seat, zip code for county clerk, date of creation, parent county or territory and records available and location (County Clerk, District Court, etc.). If the county was formed from several other counties a map shows where records for the area can be found. Also noted are courthouses that have burned.

The following chapters should be most helpful to those seeking early Texas ancestors: Early Municipalities of Texas; Mexican Law Concerning Colonization; Spanish Terms used in Land Grants and Early Deeds; Original Colonies in Texas and Land Districts of Texas.

For those seeking records after statehood the chapters on: Records Available in County Courthouses; Texas State Library; Texas State Archives; Texas General Land Office and Regional Historical Resources Depositories and Local Record Divisions; Division of Texas State Library, will be most helpful.

Libraries with resources for genealogical research are listed alphabetically by county with address and phone. However, the size and scope of the collection is not given. Dallas and Ft. Worth are listed as large libraries and Houston's Clayton is stated as best genealogy collection in the south. Nowhere is it noted that Dallas has one of the thirteen top collections in the country or that the Texas/Dallas collection has a large oral and local history collection.

GUIDE TO COUNTY RECORDS and GENEALOGICAL RESOURCES in TENNESSEE, compiled by Richard C. Fulcher, 199 pages, 6" X 9", Hardcover, \$18.50 plus postage \$1.25 first book, \$.50 each additional book, Genealogical Publishing Co., 1001 N. Calvert St., Baltimore, MD 21202. MD residents add 5% sales tax.

This alphabetical listing of Tennessee counties is a fabulous guide to

genealogical records and resources available at the Tennessee State Library and Archives, as well as microfilm records that may be purchased from the Historical Commission of the Southern Baptist Convention. This inventory of extant county records and their date of coverage was largely filmed by the LDS Genealogical Library.

The following data is given for each county: date created and from what counties; county seat and zip code; libraries; Genealogical Societies with title of their publication; published records; W.P.A. Typescript records; microfilmed records; manuscript material; church records as well as other records that are available.

1770 - 1790 CENSUS of the CUMBERLAND SETTLEMENTS, DAVIDSON, SUMNER AND TENNESSEE COUNTIES (in what is now Tennessee), compiled by Richard C. Fulcher, 6" X 9", Hardcover, 253 pages, \$20.00 plus \$1.25 postage for the first book and \$.50 for each additional book, Genealogical Publishing Co., Inc. 1001 N. Clavert St., Baltimore, MD 21202. MD residents add 5% sales tax.

As stated in the introduction, the purpose of this compilation was to identify as many families as possible in the western North Carolina settlements along the Cumberland River. This area was originally Washington Co., NC.

Inhabitants are listed in alphabetical order with information, date and reference number. Each county is treated separately with its own reference list; bibliography giving a more detailed description of some references cited and an appendix to elaborate on records of a few settlers.

As new counties were formed then subdivided on the frontier the early settlers were caught up in changing jurisdictions, without moving. Early censuses for most of this area have been lost. This creates a problem for the modern researcher. Mr. Fulcher's work is an attempt to reconstruct a census of these Cumberland River settlements.

QUAKER RECORDS IN GEORGIA, WRIGHTSBOROUGH 1772 - 1793, FRIENDSBOROUGH 1776 - 1777, by Robert S. Davis, Jr., 1987, 6" X 9", Hardcover, Everyname index, \$22.00 plus \$2.00 postage and handling, Published by Augusta Genealogical Society Inc., PO Box 3743, Augusta, GA 30904.

This book was divided into two parts, Wrightsborough and Friendsborough.

Wrightsborough: The section begins with a reprint of an article by Alex M. Hitz which listed persons receiving land grants 1770-1774. It was noted that most were identified as Quakers, however, when this list was compared with the minutes of the Friends Monthly Meetings, it was apparent that perhaps only one-fifth were Quakers.

Source and location of material were cited at the beginning of each chapter. Included in this section on Wrightsborough were: Warrants for Township - 1769; Town Lot Owners; Bush River, SC, Minutes of Men's Monthly Meetings 1772-1773; Wrightsborough, GA, Minutes of Men's Monthly Meetings 1772-1773; Records of Births and Burials 1744-1803, listed in alphabetical order; Representatives to Women's Quarterly Meeting, New Garden, NC, 1788-1792 and Bush River, SC, 1792-1801 and Quakers in the American Revolution.

The section on Friendsborough does not contain as much genealogical information as there is on Wrightsborough, since the only lists used were indentured servants and the cash book of William Mason and John Chapman 1775-1779. Appendix A lists the indentured servants of Thomas Brown and his partners.

This ancestor book contains almost 5,000 ancestors from all over the United States and the world! They are arranged alphabetically in columnar order

by both bride and groom (each couple is listed twice) with state and year of birth and death, year of marriage and spouse. Each member was assigned a number and this is used to identify the submitter. The almost 200 contributing members and their addresses are listed in numerical order in the back of the book.

MARRIAGES OF SOME AMERICAN RESIDENTS AND GUIDE TO DOCUMENTS, compiled and published by Yates Publishing Co., PO Box 237, Ozark, MO 65721. Vol. I, 1986, Soft cover, 8 1/2" X 11", 193 pages, \$8.00. Vol. II, 1986, Soft cover, 8 1/2" X 11", 246 pages, \$8.00.

These volumes were compiled from pedigree charts submitted to Yates Publishing Co. listing persons who lived in the United States or in colonies or territories which later became states.

Each volume is divided into four parts: alphabetical list by husband; alphabetical lists by wife; numerical list of documents and alphabetical lists of authors of documents.

Each entry gives approximate date of birth for both husband and wife, date of marriage, document number, type of document and number of pages in document. The numerical list of documents and alphabetical list of authors lists the address of the author as well as type of document making it possible to contact the submitter. It is also possible to order copies of the document from Yates Publishing for a small fee, making this book most helpful as many times documents are cited, but cannot be located. Many times the document may include additional family information.

NATIONAL RESEARCH DIRECTORY, NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL, 1987, AND GUIDE TO GENEALOGICAL SOCIETIES, by Keith A. Johnson and Malcolm R. Sainty, 6" X 9", Soft cover, 864 pages, published by (editors of)Genealogical Research Directory, USA representative - Mrs. N. Schreiner-Yantis, 6818 Lois Dr., Springfield, VA 22150.

This international research tool for family historians is probably one of the cheapest and most convenient means by which a person may exchange research data with persons in foreign countries doing research on the same surname. Most surnames included not only country, but also time period. A great way to locate someone in another country working on the same surname. More than 100,000 entries were submitted by some 5778 individuals from twenty countries.

The book is divided into four sections: Surnames with time period and place and identify number of contributor; numerical list of contributors; Directory of Societies by County and advertisers. Information on mailing to foreign countries is also given.

THE HEREDITARY REGISTER OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, 1986, Jerome F. Beastie, Editor, 6" X 9", Hardcover, Index by title of hereditary organizations only, The Hereditary Registry Publications, Drawer B, Yoncalla, OR 97499.

This book is divided into eight parts: Part I is probably the most often consulted: Hereditary Societies of the USA 1637-1976. The societies are listed by organizational date, background of society, objectives, membership requirements, headquarter's address and current officers. A must for anyone interested in joining a hereditary society and doesn't know where to write.

Other areas included are Introduction to Heraldry; Coats of Arms, Family Associations, Societies and Publication of the United States - only a few listed; certified genealogist - only one page; Genealogical Societies - only two listed; Revolutionary War Honor Roll; The Hereditary lists; The State of Liberty; The First Washington Monument; NSDAR and NASA Honor Roll give biographical information on some members of these organization. I did not find were it was stated how these were selected or who was ask to submit information.

OUR QUAKER ANCESTORS, (Finding Them in Quaker Records), by Ellen Thomas Berry & David Allen Berry. 136 pages, cloth, \$17.50, postage and handling (1 book) \$2.00, ea. additional book \$.75. MasterCard/VISA acceptable (Furnish acct. no., exp. date, and signature). (MD residents - 5% tax).

The Berrys are the second husband/wife Certified Genealogists in the United States, and collaborate on writing and lecturing about Quakers. Mr. Berry, who holds a bachelor's degree in Organic Chemistry from Marietta (OH) College and has done graduate work in both chemistry and economics at Ohio State University, also lectures on techniques common to science and genealogy. Mrs. Berry has written several journal articles on land acquisition. They have co-authored two books on the allocation of land in the Northwest Territory.

In 1675, when George Fox devised the system of record-keeping integral to the Religious Society of Friends (Quakers), he could hardly have foreseen the uses to which these meticulous and extensive records would be put. Friends "meeting" records are a mine of undreamed genealogical riches. However, they have characteristics and a language all their own, making them difficult to use.

On this premise, OUR QUAKER ANCESTORS details the types of records available, their locations, and the proper and effective use of those records, guiding the researcher through the Pyramidal "meeting" structure to the records of birth, marriage, death, disownment, and removal to be found in record repositories across the country. Information contained in this book is indispensable for anyone tracing ancestors who were either birthright members of the Society, or who became members through "convincement" or marriage.

GOING TO AMERICA, by Terry Coleman. 317 pp., illus., paperback (1972), repr. 1987, \$14.95, postage and handling (1 book) \$2.00, ea. additional book \$.75. MasterCard/VISA acceptable (Furnish acct. no., exp. date, and signature). (MD residents - 5% tax).

This is the grim story of the British/Irish immigrants who came to America during the middle of the nineteenth century. Much the largest contingent was Irish, and it was above all the departure of the Irish to America, diseased, half-starved, bewildered, cheated and cheating, which made the emigrant way across the Atlantic as degrading as the convict route to the South Sea, and almost as cruel as the Middle Passage of the slave ships.

According to THE TIMES (London), "This momentous movement, so heroic in retrospect, so shabby at the time, has now found its perfect chronicler, Terry Coleman.
