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EDITOR'S DESK

After fearing that there would be a shortage of material for this issue, it developed there was an overabundance of material of every nature. I have had to hold up resuming publication of the Dallas County Deed Records until our June issue, as well as a compilation of the records of the Trees Cemetery in Cedar Hill, Texas prepared by our member Mrs. Betty Brooks and her nephew Bradley C. Hodge.

On the other hand, I am also receiving some materials it is not possible to use -- for instance -- lengthy family records and charts that would be of most value, I believe, in the Vertical Files of the Genealogical Section of the Public Library. In such cases, if the submitter's cover letter includes a query, I use the query and forward the materials to Lloyd Bockstruck for the Vertical Files. How many of you have consulted the Vertical Files in your searching? When you receive materials that don't really apply to your own family search, remember that others looking for that information might find it if you give materials you can't use to the Library for these manuscript files. And, as you know, we do not accept advertising. However, since I did furnish information about the Doherty family association, I also wrote up information about other such groups on the page entitled "Family Associations and Publications."

As I mentioned last month, we cannot use any more completed Family Charts in the quarterly. The three that appear this month complete my obligation to those who submitted Charts last year, when I had suggested we might have another issue of the Ancestral Charts, such as we published in 1975. These six charts were all I received, so I felt they should be published. Any other charts sent to me will be given to Lloyd for the Vertical Files. In the meantime, the soon-to-be published membership listing, including the names of families we are researching, will serve that purpose.

The Antique Week (formerly titled The Tri-State Trader), of Knightstown, Indiana, in its issue of March 2, 1987, announces that The Ohio Genealogical Society Library at Mansfield, Ohio, is purchasing the International Genealogical Index file on microfiche of the Genealogical Society of Utah, beginning with United States Listings. As Lloyd Bockstruck announced at our last meeting, a member of our society has contributed a sum of money to be used to obtain this complete Index on a world-wide scale for our Dallas Library. This Index has been ordered and should be received at any time. I'll check with Lloyd to see if there are any special instructions for its use he'd like to include in the June quarterly. He has contributed some very useful instructions on finding when and how our immigrant ancestors came into this country (See Page 22 of this issue).

You will recall that we reprinted an article from The Connecticut Nutmegger last June warning of ads received from Beatrice Bayley and from Sharon Taylor and others claiming to have published a genealogy on your family which they would send you for \$29.85. Now a new wrinkle has been added. Mailings are being received from an outfit called the Genealogy Room in Scranton, Pennsylvania. These are computer printouts (cards and letters) signed by "Elizabeth Ross." The name seems to be innocuous, except that in each case Elizabeth Ross has adopted as her middle name the surname of the person she is writing. I received a card from Elizabeth Brengel Ross. One friend, Lillian Mankus, received a card from Elizabeth Mankus Ross. Please be forewarned that you will find no family history in these so-called genealogies that could not be obtained from combing telephone books,

HONORING LUCILE ANDERSON BOYKIN
ON HER RETIREMENT FROM
THE DALLAS PUBLIC LIBRARY

The Dallas Genealogical Society extends to Mrs. Boykin our love and appreciation for her many years of service to us and to the Dallas Metroplex in the many offices she has held in the Dallas Public Library in the past thirty years.

A native of Osborne, Kansas, where her family lived on a farm, she moved to town with her mother and sister following her father's death in 1927. In high school she sang in glee club, played string bass in the orchestra, and participated in Christian Endeavor of the First Presbyterian Church. An avid reader from the first grade on, her interest in a library career and in family research were inspired when, as a high school junior, she worked in the Osborne Carnegie Library.

Following her graduation from State Teachers College in Emporia, Kansas, with a Bachelor of Science in Education, majoring in library science, in 1946 she held several positions as high school librarian, bookmobile librarian and head librarian in Ottawa, Kansas; Lamar, Colorado; Santa Maria, California; and Jackson County, Michigan. From 1949 to 1953, she attended the University of Denver, where she did graduate work in sociology.

In the fall of 1955, Lucile Anderson Boykin began her career in Texas, as a teacher of the mentally retarded, in Cleburne. A year later, in fall, 1956, she came to the Dallas Public Library, where she was a cataloguer, becoming Department Head, Serials, July, 1958 to November, 1961. Following a two-year stint in which she supervised five military libraries in Korea, she returned to the Dallas Public Library in 1963 as Department Head, Texas History and Genealogy. With a shift in departmental organization, her title, July 1973 to 1980, became Section

Head, Genealogy Library, History and Society Sciences Division. From 1980 to November, 1985, she was titled Specialist, Texas/Dallas History and Archives. From December, 1985, until her retirement, she has served as Manager of that division.

A Life Member of the American Library Association and of the Dallas Genealogical Society, Mrs. Boykin also holds memberships in the Texas Library Association, Dallas County Library Association, Society of American Archivists, American State and Local History Association, Texas State Historical Association, and Texas State Genealogical Society. She is an elder in the First Presbyterian Church, and has maintained membership in the American Legion Auxiliary for fifty years.

Continuing the tradition established by her predecessor, Mrs. Margaret Pratt, she has provided vital leadership during years of growing interest in genealogy through her roles of assisting patrons at the library and working closely with officers and directors of the Dallas Genealogical Society.

Her one sister, Dr. Myrta Jane Anderson, of Topeka, Kansas, is a specialist in Elections and State Government under the aegis of the Kansas State Legislative Research Council, an arm of the Kansas State Legislature.

Mrs. Boykin's future plans include church activities, researching and writing family research, and traveling with her sister to Scotland and perhaps a return trip to Ireland and Germany. Volunteer activities may also become a part of her retirement, as well as visiting art galleries, reading, and enjoying symphony, theater, and opera programs. She chooses to continue living in Dallas, where her many friends have made it her home.

All members of the Dallas Genealogical Society extend to Lucile Anderson Boykin our deep appreciation for her many years of dedicated service and assistance to us, and our wishes for a long life filled with happy days.

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THE O'DOCHARTAIGHS ARE COMING!

The Tri-State Trader, a bi-weekly publication of Knightstown, Indiana, in an article headed as above, dated Mar. 11, 1985, warned Ireland to beware, as it was expected that some 4,000 O'Dochartaigh clansmen might drop in for a visit during that summer. This warning had been received from Patrick Dougherty of Burton, Michigan, who heads the international O'Dochartaigh Family Research Association. The O'Dochartaigh surname has been anglicized as Daugherty, Doherty and Dority, and as many as 120 other variations on the original name.

Patrick Dougherty came up with the 'reunion' idea in 1977 when he visited Donegal, Ireland, and discussed it with local officials there. Returning to Michigan, he helped expand the Canadian O'Dochartaigh club into a worldwide association, with a mailing list of some 5,000 names. It was expected that the reunion would be attended by descendants from the United States, Great Britain, Australia, Canada, South America, Japan, Spain and Africa.

Leaflets and posters were passed out in Donegal and Londonderry announcing the projected O'Dochartaigh invasion. The government of Northern Ireland was said to have planned spending at least \$450,000.00 to build a replica of Ft. O'Dochartaigh, last stronghold of the clan chieftain, Cahir O'Dochartaigh. The chieftain burned down the original fort to spite the invading British in 1608--and was beheaded for his petulance. The replica complex was also to house a \$40,000 computer in which an international record of O'Dochartaighs and other northern Irish surnames would be recorded for a genealogy institute.

Pat Dougherty reported that the family association has helped put hundreds of distant relatives in touch with each other throughout the world, including descendants of Irish who fled to Spain and elsewhere in 1697 in resistance to British suppression.

Mr. Dougherty planned to retire in that same year of 1985 and move to Donegal to start his own genealogical archives in an old English manor house that the association leases on a small island near Londonderry. Though he hasn't traced any of his relatives to Donegal yet, he felt it wouldn't matter. for when he arrived, they would all be his cousins!

Address of the O'Dochartaigh family was given as P O Box 98, Attica, Michigan 48412. (Although word now has it that Mr. Dougherty and family now reside in Donegal, Ireland, where they manage the O'Dochartaigh castle purchased by the O'Dochartaigh Family Society!)

PASSENGER LISTS OF VESSELS ARRIVING AT NEW YORK, N. Y., 1820-1897.
M237, 675 ROLLS -

This micropublication contains the names, ages, places of nativity and/or origin of passengers arriving at the port of New York City between the years of 1820 and 1897, arranged in chronological order.

It is imperative that a researcher have some idea of the year of immigration of an ancestor in order to locate him or her in this massive body of data. For the earlier years, one can use the Index to Passenger Lists of Vessels Arriving at New York, N. Y., 1820-1846, M261, 103 rolls. If the immigrant arrived after 1846, it may be possible to locate his or her name in these records by using other publications.

If the immigrant originated in Ireland and immigrated in the era of the potato famine, consult The Famine Immigrants, Lists of Irish Immigrants Arriving at the Port of New York 1846-1861, 7 vols., R929.3/F198.

If the immigrant was from Sweden, consult: Nils Olsson, Swedish Passenger Arrivals in New York 1820-1850, R929.3/N7NEO.

If the immigrant debarked from Europe through the port of Bremen, he or she may be included in the reconstructed records for that port based on the records in this micropublication. Consult: Gary J. Zimmerman, German Immigrants: Lists of Passengers Bound from Bremen to New York 1847-1857 with Places of Origin, R929,30893.Z72G, and -----, German Immigrants: Passengers Bound from Bremen to New York 1855-1862.

(It should be emphasized that all nationalities emigrated from the port of Bremen, so these volumes are not limited to Teutonic peoples.)

If the immigrant originated in the Netherlands, examine the two-volume work of Robert P. Swierenga, Dutch Immigrants in U.S. Ship Passenger Manifests, 1820-1880, an Alphabetical Listing by Household Heads and Independent Persons, R929.20893/S9760.

(The code number for those arriving at the port of New York is four.)

Michael Cassaday has extracted various lists from this micropublication and some of these have appeared in New York Passenger Arrivals 1849-1868, Passenger Lists, R929.373//C343N.

He has also submitted numerous other lists to genealogical periodicals across the nation. To locate these, consult Passenger and Immigration Lists Index, a Guide to Published Arrival Records.... R929.37/P287, and Genealogical Periodical Annual Index, R016.929/G326. The former provides access under the name of the immigrant if that name appears in a printed source. Some such lists are so recent that they remain to be indexed. Many of these lists have appeared in genealogical periodicals, and GPAI is the tool for locating the appropriate titles, volumes and pages of periodicals containing such data.

If none of the above indexes identify the immigrant ancestor, one must search the reels of microfilm frame by frame. Do remember that if any of the immigrant's family members who were foreign born were alive in 1900, they had to provide the year of immigration to the census taker. Such information would narrow the period of time for a search of the records in this micropublication.

If the immigrant arrived after this set ends, please consult the micropublication, Index to Passenger Lists of Vessels Arriving at New York, N. Y., June 16, 1897-June 30, 1902, Series T519, 115 Rolls.

If the immigrant came between July 1, 1902 and December 31, 1943, there is a soundex to the passenger lists for the port of New York, but the library does not own this set of 744 reels. A few units have been donated.

June 21, 1911 -

Introduction of testimony in the Otto Giesecke case, on trial in the Criminal District Court, will begin this morning at 9 o'clock, the last of the jurors having been selected yesterday afternoon. Both the State and the defense have exercised many precautions in selecting the jury and both sides used nearly all of their peremptory challenges. It is alleged that Giesecke shot and killed H. H. Burney in a rooming house on Young Street last May.

June 23, 1911

The first instance of the operation of the new law requiring the written consent of parents in the case of the marriage of persons under age came up yesterday at the court house, when W. E. Myers applied for a license to marry Miss L. M. Quinn, who was under 18 years of age. It was necessary to adjourn a case being tried in Judge Seay's court in order that the young lady's father, George W. Quinn, who is on the jury in the Giesecke case, might be permitted to write his consent to the marriage. This is the first case of the enforcement of the new marriage license law in this county.

FISH FAMILY RECORDS AND LINES, Volume I, by Laurine Mae Palmerton Logsdon, South 2827 Ivory, Spokane, WA 99203. 8 1/2" X 11", soft cover, 40 pages, 2 everyname indexes; one for Fish and one for other surnames. \$5.50 plus \$1.00 postage and handling, WA residents add \$.43 tax. Published irregularly 2 or 3 times a year.

A surname booklet of compiled materials relating to Fish families. Three sections: records, lineage, and queries.

This issue includes marriage records from the states of OH, RI, NY, NJ, and SAR records of PA, as well as Baptisms, births, cemetery and death records from these areas. Military pension records from the Revolutionary War, War of 1812 and New Jersey County Militia were given for the surname Fish. It was not stated if these were all there were, or a partial list.

The lineage section gave lineages for John Fish and Thomas Fish of England; Stephen Fish of MA; Anna Fish of Saratoga Co., NY; John Fish of NC, and Ellery D. Fish of VT. Sources of records as well as sources in the lineages are listed, helping the researcher to locate the record or know what was searched.

WILKES RECORDS 1216-1984 by Lillian Jones Crews, 2001 Shady Oaks Dr, Tallahassee, FL 32303, published 1984, second edition 1986. 8 1/2" X 11", soft-cover, spiral binding, 283+ pages (1986 additions given page number and letter, i.e. 72a). Three everyname indexes: Wilkes surname; general index and 1986 addition.

The book is divided into three sections on Wilkes families with the references listed at the end of each section. The first three letters or the initials of the source are given in capitals and underlined in the text. They are then listed in alphabetical order in the Reference Section.

Section One discusses the earliest Wilkes in England and America, while Section Two is an introduction to the author's Wilkes family, four brothers - John, Joseph, Minor and Benjamin - and their descendants. Section Three list other Wilkes Families and is divided into two parts with each part having its own reference section: Part 1) Francis Wilks of Loudoun Co., VA; Part 2) NY Wilkes Family, Francis Wilkes family of NC and SC.

The Appendix - Allied families, Miscellaneous, has its own reference Section and lists such families as Banks, Crews, Fanley, Snead, Stanfield and others.

PROUD HERITAGE, PIONEER FAMILIES OF DALLAS COUNTY, compiled by Dallas County Pioneers Association, published by Taylor Publishing Company of Dallas, 9" X 11 1/2", 300 pages including an everyname index. \$32.50 includes

The "Pioneers of Dallas County" were organized July 13, 1875 at a meeting held in the court house and attended by 112 people. Annual picnics were planned, and there are records of many such events in the years since.

A 1910 newspaper article stated that "during the thirty-seven years the Association has been in existence, not a year has passed without a reunion of old people...". If this is true, there is much history still to be recorded, according to a former president of the association, W. F. Jacoby, Jr., who hopes to locate annual printed programs, secretaries' files and minutes of the meetings.

The Dallas County Pioneers Association was reorganized in 1979 and its enthusiastic members visualized a book featuring stories of the early families who conquered the raw frontier area which became the great modern Dallas County we know today.

Recently the book became a reality and is a charming collection of biographical sketches written by descendants of the founding families and enhanced by many excellent photographs of individuals, family groups and early Dallas homes. Historic preservationists will bewail the loss of these homes which showed Dallas as it used to be.

Approximately two hundred families are represented in this book, "Proud Heritage, Pioneer Families of Dallas County", giving insight into the joys and hardships of pioneer life in Texas. If you have ever wondered where Dallas County streets and landmarks got their names, many of your questions will be answered by this book.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN TO YOUR RESEARCH?

PLEASE do not paste family papers in scrapbooks, or glue and scotch tape to repair them. Two other dangerous practices are laminating and using the type of photo albums that cover with a piece of plastic. These are fine for some things, but not those things you wish to last lifetimes. If you do not know "what to do" consult your library, or archives. Remember that most papers contain acids, and eventually "eat each other up. "

And -- are you carefully noting on the reverse of each picture, in a manner that will not harm the picture -- a record of persons, places and times shown?

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
