For the census years 1850 through 1880, the census takers were to report if there had been a death in the household within the past year and the details were to be given on the Mortality Schedule. In 1850 and 1860 these deaths were listed by precinct but there was no correlation between the family numbers on the census and the numbers on the mortality schedule. In 1880, there was a space for a number on the form which would correspond to the family number on the Population Schedule. The family numbers were not used in Enumeration Districts 54-57, which were abstracted in Volume 36, Number 3, or in Enumeration Districts 63 and 67.

There were two additional columns in the original that have not been transcribed. One is headed " If the Disease was not contracted at the place of death, state the place." The other is headed " Name of attending Physician." The first column was rarely filled in while the name of the physician was usually noted.

The instructions to the enumerators stated that when it was not possible to make a positive statement, as when an age could only be estimated, the entry should be enclosed by parentheses. Some entries had a line through them, this seems to denote that the death occurred in another place. Some spaces were left blank. These are reproduced in the transcription. "???" were added to indicate that something was written but I could not determine the exact word, letter or number.

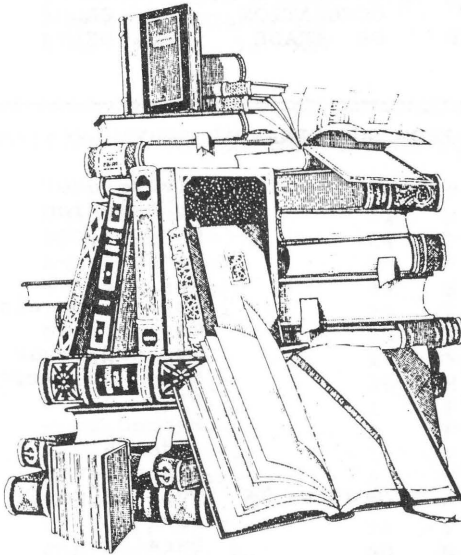

## BOOK REVIEWS

### IRISH FAMILY HISTORY.

Marilyn Yurdan. 1990. Hardback, 6" x 9", xii plus 194 pages. Indexed. \$19.95 plus \$2.50 P&H. Order from Genealogical Publishing Company, 1001 N. Calvert Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202.

**IRISH FAMILY HISTORY** is something of a misnomer. It is not a family history in the usual genealogical sense of the word; no reference whatsoever is made to individual families. Rather, the "history" part is an enlightening dissertation on Irish culture, demography, religion, and politics. But the book is a good deal more than just that. From a genealogical standpoint, it might well be called "What's Where in Ireland, and How to Go About finding It". It lists the records that are available, where they are located, and explains the information one can expect to obtain from them. Several examples are provided, with descriptive commentary, of census, marriage and burial records. Five simple but helpful maps are included. Church records are covered in some detail. Practical, down to earth advice is given on planning a trip to Ireland, and how to get the most out of it.

Finally there is an extensive list of repositories, what each contains, and directions on how to get to each one. The index is only two pages but seems to be adequate.

If any of your ancestral lines go back to Ireland, and you decide to research them, this book will be a thorough, reliable and "user friendly" guide as you begin your work.

Mrs. Thetford writes a wonderful genealogical column which appears twice weekly in *THE DALLAS MORNING NEWS*. It has an enthusiastic following among DGS members, and indeed, throughout the *NEWS* circulation of over a third of a million. Since the "how to's", "where to's", queries, book reviews, notices, etc., contained in the articles are not restricted to Texas, they cover a wide geographic range of genealogical interest.

All 1006 **FAMILY TREE** columns published from 10 November 1979 to 30 December 1989 are now available in one package, either on microfilm or microfiche. Each film frame contains one column. The first three years were copied from previously published books, with the remainder filmed directly from newspaper clippings. At the end of each year's columns there is a name index for that year, with five years also indexed by topic and place. The ten yearly indexes contain a total of over 31,00 entries.

If you enjoy **FAMILY TREE** regularly as I do, how many times have you wished for access to a past column, containing a key piece of information which you failed to save? Now, thanks to Margaret Ann, not only do we have access to all her columns through 1989, we also have an easy way to locate what we're seeking. Thank you, Mrs. Thetford!

**AMELIA COUNTY, VIRGINIA WILL BOOK 3, 1780-1786; WILL BOOK 4, 1786-1792; WILL BOOK 5, 1793-1799.** Bell Hubbard Wise. 1990. Paperback, 8 ½" x 11"; Book 3 is 76 pages, Book 4 is 58 pages, Book 5 is 57 pages. All three books are name indexed. Each volume is \$10.00 postpaid; Texas residents add \$.83 per volume state sales tax. Order from Powell Publishing Co., Box 1466, Weatherford, Texas 76087.

After two trips to Virginia and one microfilm reading, still another ancestor of Ms. Wise's turned up in Amelia County. At that point she ordered the microfilm once more and copied all the wills, and is now sharing the results with others. In addition to abstracts of all entries found in the Will Books, these volumes contain additional deaths and heirs from the Order Books for the same period.

Although the pages are printed on only one side, the print is large and easy to read. The abstractions are quite cursory, containing primarily names and dates, with a minimum of description. Over 1500 names appear in the Book 3 index; the other two contain about 1000 each.

Mr. Finnell and other MGS members have compiled an index of every name which appears on the 1886 plat maps of Faribault County. Each name in the Index includes the township and section where the name can be found. Following the index are twenty pages of the 1886 township maps which show land ownership at that time. Reference to the Index will quickly determine if someone you are interested in owned property in Faribault County in 1886. If so, you can find the section and within it, the plat of your party's property on the township map. Like an early day MAPSCO !!

I find the American Rectangular Land Survey System, which was followed precisely in laying out Minnesota, to be awfully dull but convenient. Each county is divided into 6 by 6 mile townships, which are in turn divided into 36 sections of one square mile each. Property is described in fractions or multiples of sections, so all fence lines run north south or east west. How boring! But how easy it is to define property lines that way, and it's mighty easy to use this Plat Book Index.

Minnesota Genealogical Society has available Plat Book Indexes for the following counties in an identical format. Each is \$12.00, with P&H \$1.25 for the first, and \$.50 for each additional item. The counties, all in extreme south western Minnesota, and the Plat Book dates are:

## INTRODUCTION

The GUIDE TO *THE DALLAS QUARTERLY*, VOLUMES I -XXXVI, 1955-1990 has evolved from the GUIDE TO *THE QUARTERLY* 1955-1982. Eight more volumes of the quarterly have been printed since the original Guide. Since the Guide is designed as a finding aid for articles of interest in the quarterly, it seemed appropriate to incorporate it in the final issue of the 36th volume of *THE DALLAS QUARTERLY*.

The first publication of the Local History and Genealogical society was published February 21, 1955. It came out rather sporadically at first, but by March of 1958 it was called a quarterly and was published four times a year. Although there have been several name changes through the years, the frequency of publication (4 times a year) and the format have remained essentially the same.

The family tree logo that we still use first appeared on the cover designed by Carol Kupfer of Volume XXI, # 3 (1975). In 1977, the Local History and Genealogical Society name was changed to the Dallas Genealogical Society and the publication was known as *THE QUARTERLY*. In 1982, the size of *THE QUARTERLY* changed and it was published in a 5 ½" x 8 ½" size. In 1984, the publication became known as *THE DALLAS QUARTERLY* and it is still published in this form.

As Margaret Ann Hudson, Dallas Genealogical Society president 1983-1984, said in the introduction to the original guide:

This Guide has been prepared for use in conjunction with either the printed copies of the Dallas Genealogical Society's Quarterlies or with the Quarterlies on microfilm. [Please see inside back cover for availability of back issues and ordering information.]

A committee of members of the Dallas Genealogical Society carefully reviewed all the articles and placed each in a category. This cross-referencing was done to help you, the reader, locate just the information you've been searching for! We recommend that you check all categories.

This edition of the Guide follows the format of the original with very little change. Several new categories were added and some were expanded but essentially it works the same. The volume and issue number are given for each article; it should be noted that the exact title of the article may be paraphrased in an attempt to clarify the content or precise scope of the item.
