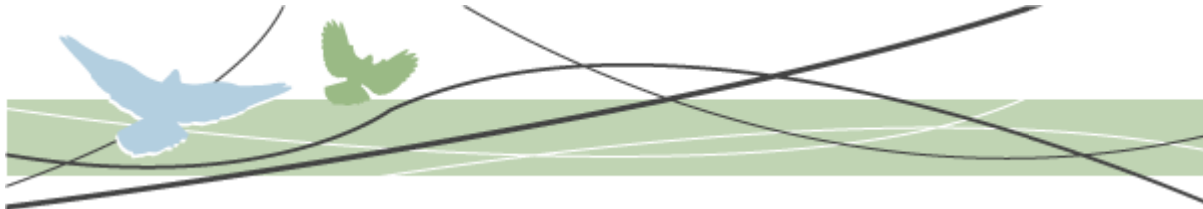

Our speaker:

John A. Sellers is a fifth generation native to Hopkins County, Texas. He graduated from Texas Tech University, and he has been doing genealogical research since 1985. His favorite area of research is in the courthouse. He is active member of the Hopkins County Genealogical Society and has served fourteen years on the executive board. John is currently serving as 1st Vice President. He was a speaker at both the FGS National Conference in 1997 and 2004, and

NGS in 1994. He was the featured speaker at the DRT Genealogical Conference at the Alamo in 2002 and 2003, and the Louisiana Historical and Genealogical Seminar in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, 2007. He was a featured speaker at Dallas Texas Summer Institute, 2006. John, was a lecturer at the Institute of Genealogical Research, Samford University, 2009 and has been invited to return in 2010. He compiled an addendum to the 1850 Census of Hopkins County.

John's presentation will be "Dusty Books and Musty Rooms" A Texas Courthouse Study- A general overview of courthouse research, etiquette, and procedures. The lecture will address all types of courthouse records and how to access them. Probate and deed records will be emphasized as well as unique Texas records and laws.
