In 2014, our journal was awarded First Place, Category VI (Official Periodicals of Partner Societies/Journals) by the Texas State Genealogical Society.

The DGS Publications Committee cites an age-old question: “How do you eat an elephant? Answer: One bite at a time.” The same might be true of how you write a family history – one story at a time, until you have a collection that can be passed down for generations. Even if you have only one story you want to write, that is a worthy accomplishment.
