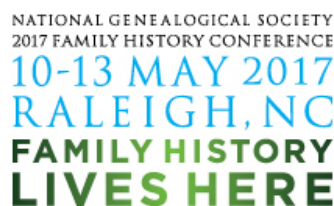
- zoom in and out of maps for the level of detail desired
